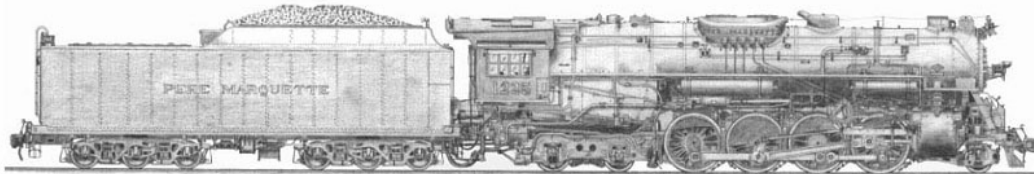
William Depue Drake (1936-2003)
