

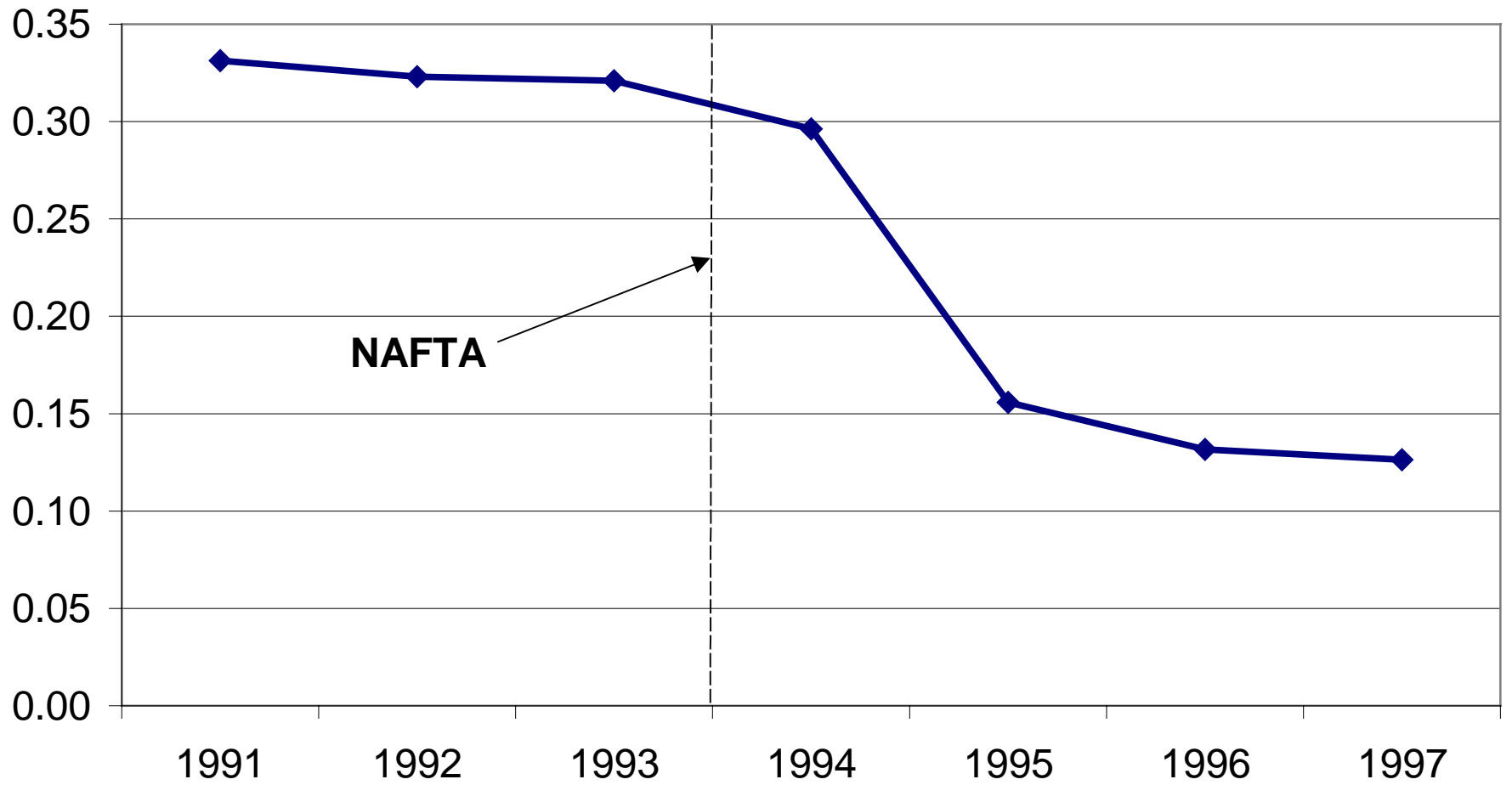

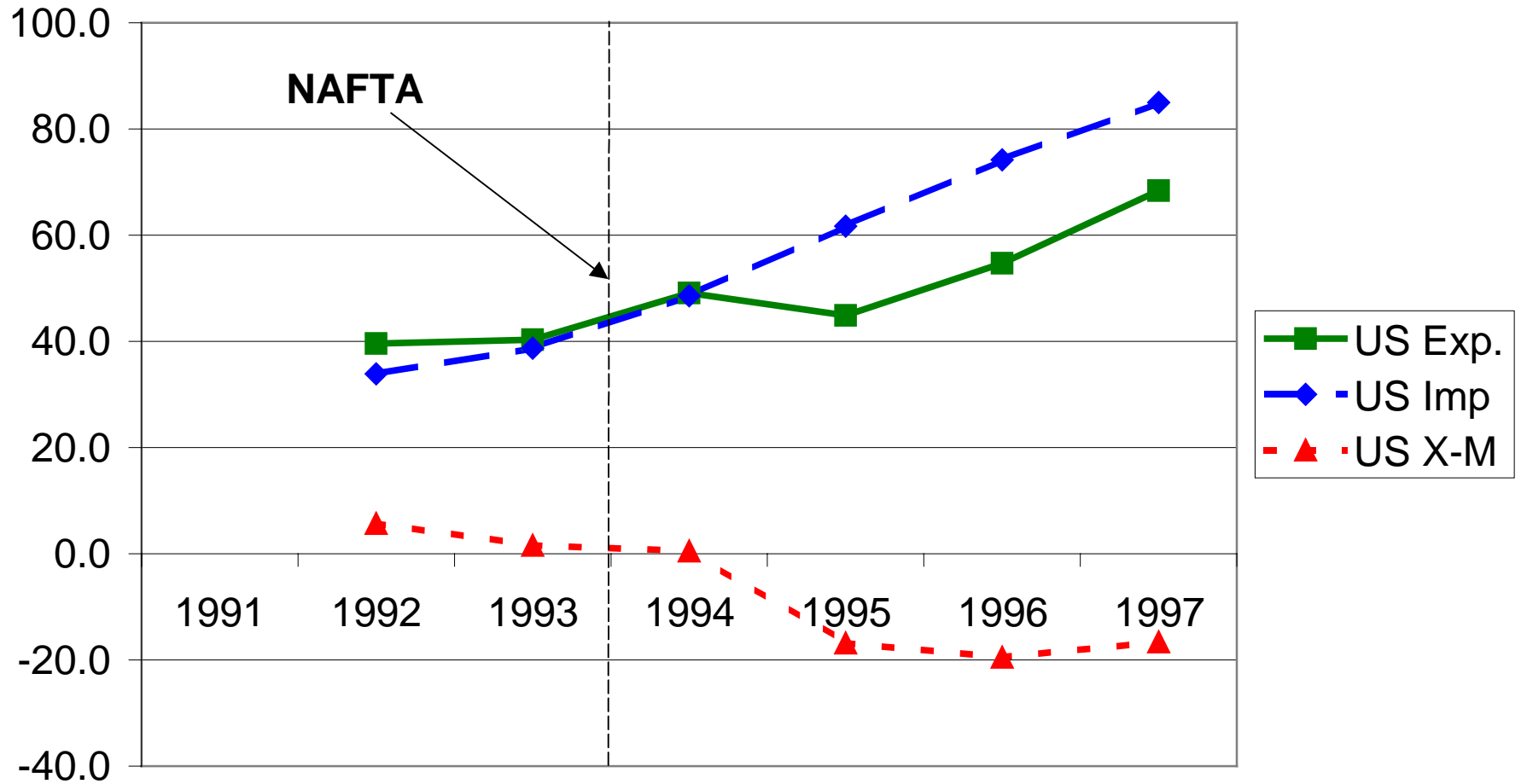

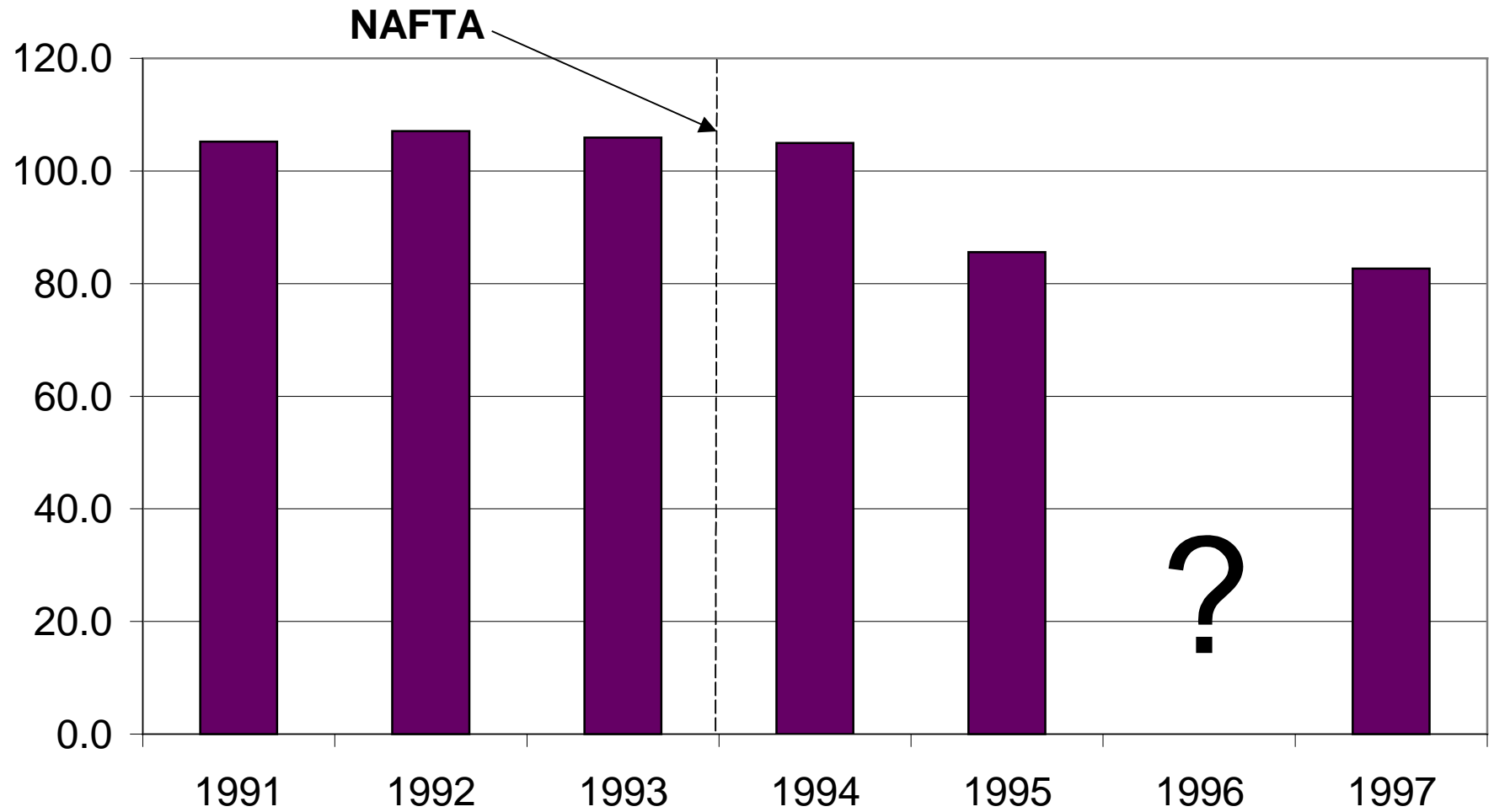
Mexican Exchange Rate \$/Peso
