This is an open event for all cars and drivers. We intend this to be a fun, enjoyable, educational day at the track where you can stretch your car's legs a bit, and improve your driving skills. In this **non-competitive** event, we will give the maximum track time possible, rain or shine. Cars will be grouped by performance potential and drivers' track experience. **This is not a race.**

Drivers Sessions:

Requirements

Snell SA 1990 or later approved helmets (eye shield for open cars) M rated helmets not recommended

Roll bars for ALL open cars (must meet AROC competition code;
<http://www.aroc-usa.org/community/AROCCompCodeJuly2004.pdf>)

Stock 3 point, 5 or 6 point harness (**NO 2 point or 4 point- strictly enforced**)

Remember, this is a **non-competitive** event- no wheel to wheel driving!! You may be warned or dismissed for spinning, leaving the track surface, wheel-to-wheel driving or otherwise endangering yourself or others. Any car-to-car contact is grounds for expulsion from the event. We want this to be a safe and fun event. This is not a race.

Touring Sessions:

During the lunch break, all drivers will be allowed slow touring laps of the track (no helmet or roll bars are required). Speeds will be limited by pace cars, no passing will be allowed, one passenger maximum per vehicle, and all drivers' session warnings will be enforced as well. "**Touring Only**" is available for \$20.

Registration Fees:

AROC members:	\$110*
Non-members:	\$125*
Touring Only:	\$20

*A **\$20 discount** will be applied to all drivers' applications that *also* register for the Saturday, October 15th AROC event at GingerMan Raceway (\$20 total discount for driving both events).

There will be a \$20 late fee for all applications postmarked October 5 or later.

An *additional \$20 late fee* is charged for registering at the track on event day (\$40 total late fee).

Garages are available at the track for \$50 each.

We will allow 55 drivers to register for the Drivers Sessions. Entries accepted in order of receipt, AROC members given first priority. **The track will charge a \$10.00 entry fee to each person entering the track.** Track phone number is (616) 691-7221.
