

Addendum to Section 103 Syllabus

I will grade problem sets out of 10 points. I will give some minor indication of what you have done wrong when I mark off points, but I will not indicate the correct solution; that is what the solution sets are for.

I will use the following scale, including integers in between:

- 10=everything correct
- 9=a few very minor mistakes
- 8=solid work with some mistakes
- 7=below average
- 5=Half right, half wrong
- 2=Very little right
- 0=Nothing right or failed to turn in.

The problems must be handed in as specified on Professor Kaufman's syllabus. If the problem is due before lecture, it will suffer a late penalty if handed in after lecture.

The late penalty is as follows:

- 1 day late = -1 point
- 2 days late = -2 or -3 points
- 3 days late = severe penalty.
