

Connecting to IFS from Mac OS X

The intended audience for this document is end-users. This document is specific to Mac computers built with the LSA image.

SHORTCUTS

For your convenience, an LSA Mac-imaged computer provides you with a shortcut to your IFS space on your desktop. It is called "IFS Home" and clicking on it will automatically take you to your ITCS file-storage space and you can drag files and folders there. Be careful not to confuse this with the LSA Windows servers, which also provide you with file-storage space.

BEFORE clicking on this shortcut, be sure you have an AFS token. You can get this by getting a Kerberos ticket using the Kerberos utility found in /Applications/Utilities/Kerberos. You may already have a Kerberos ticket (and thus an AFS token) if you've recently used OS X Mail, to read your email or if you used your Kerberos password to login to the computer.



APPLICATIONS
