

Installing MS-Remote Desktop Connection

The intended audience for this document is end-users.

With Remote Desktop Connection Client for Mac, you can connect from your Macintosh computer to a Windows-based computer and work with programs and files on that computer.



Remote Desktop Connect may already be installed on your computer. Check your /Applications/Microsoft Office 2004/Additional Tools/Remote Desktop Connection/Remote Desktop Connection/ folder. If you cannot locate it, try using Spotlight on your Mac. If you still cannot locate it, you can install it using the instructions below.

- Go to the website <http://www.microsoft.com/mac>
- Click on OTHER PRODUCTS
- Click on REMOTE DESKTOP
- Click DOWNLOAD NOW
- Click on ENGLISH (.bin) in the left column
 - The application will begin to download.
 - Your computer will warn you that you are downloading an application.
 - It will expand the RDC103EN.dmg file.
 - It will create a volume on your desktop called "Remote Desktop Connection."
 - It will open a new window on your desktop.



- Copy the FOLDER from this volume into your APPLICATIONS folder on your hard drive
