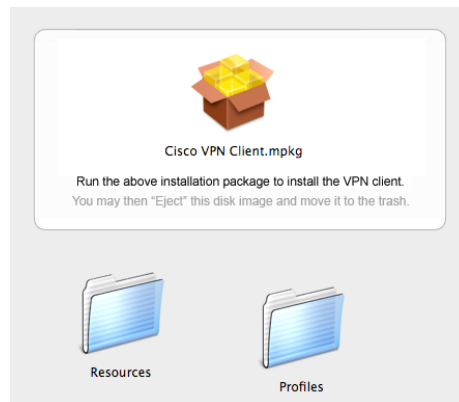
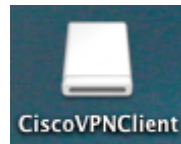


# Installing Virtual Private Network (VPN)

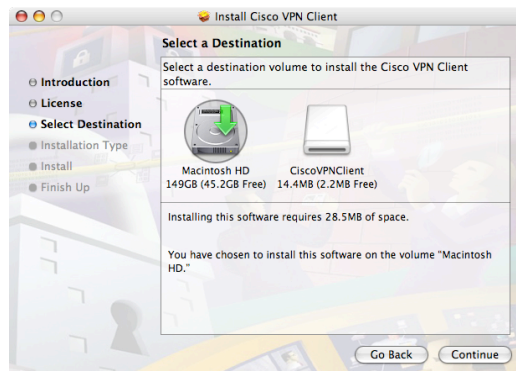
The intended audience for this document is end-users.

*With VPN Client you can connect to services on the UM Network as if you were in your office. This application will be especially helpful to users who have issues of port-blocking from their ISPs at home.*

- Go to the website <http://www.itcom.itd.umich.edu/vpn/software/mac.html>
- Click on "Download the Cisco VPN client and U-M VPN profiles for Mac OS 10.4 (PPC and Intel)" in the middle of the page
- A volume will appear on your desktop called "CiscoVPNClient" and it will open a new window on your desktop
- Double Click on the Cisco VPN Client.mpkg item to install VPN



- If asked, install the software ON YOUR HARD DRIVE (often called "Macintosh HD")
