4. Joshua Wolf has, in person and through counsel, refused to comply with the grand jury 1 2 subpoena without just cause; and 5. Based on this refusal, Joshua Wolf is in civil contempt of this Court. 3 4 Based on the foregoing findings of fact, and for the reasons stated in open court, it is 5 6 hereby **ORDERED** that Joshua Wolf be confined at a suitable place until such time as he is 7 willing to give such testimony or provide such information as required by the grand jury subpoena. The period of confinement shall not exceed the life of the term of the grand jury, 8 including extensions, and in no event shall exceed eighteen months. 9 The witness's motion for bail pending appeal is **DENIED**.
