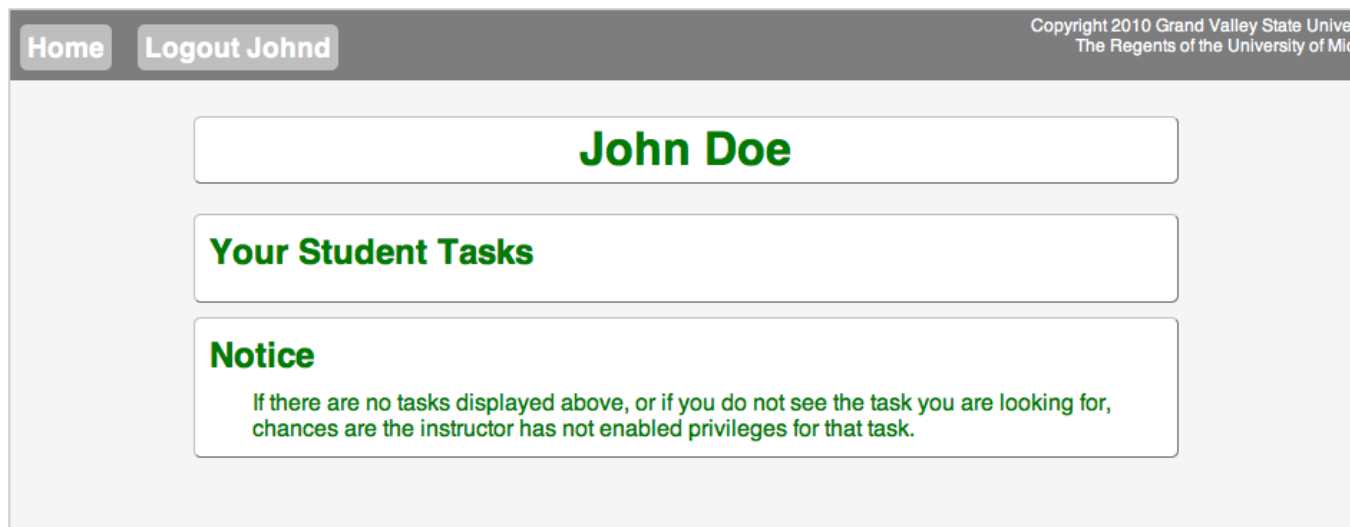


Using Cornichon for DiLL Feedback

Cornichon URL: <http://lrc-tsukemono.lrc.lsa.umich.edu/cornichon>

Log in to Cornichon at the above URL with your UM username and password.

When you log in, you will see a screen like this:



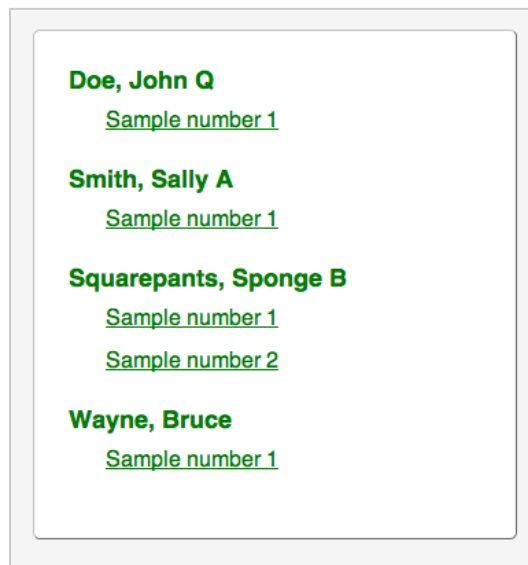
In the area labeled “Your Student Tasks”, you should see a list of the available tasks. If you do not see the task you’re looking for, then your instructor will have to enable the appropriate permissions to view it.

Click on the task you would like to work in.

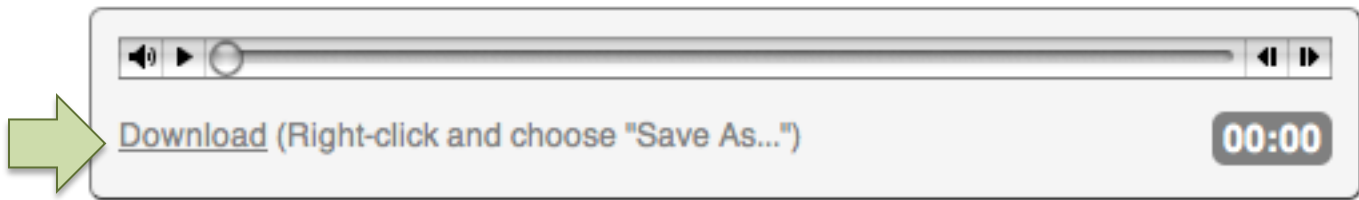
Recordings List:

In the task page, you will see a list of recordings that looks like the image on the right. Depending on the permissions set by your instructor for this task, you might only see your recordings.

Clicking on the name of a recording will bring up the audio player in the column on the right, along with any comments for that recording (if discussion permissions have been enabled).



The Audio Player:



On the audio player, you may have the option to download and save the file to your computer if your instructor has enabled that permission. To do so, right-click the “Download” link and choose “Save as...” from the menu.

Leaving Feedback:

If discussion has been enabled, you can leave feedback on recordings with the comment form.

If you would like to leave text feedback only, fill in the form with your feedback text.

Contextual Feedback:

If your comment is referencing a particular point in the audio, you can navigate to that point

in the player, click the pause button, then click the button on the form labeled “Insert Current Timecode”. This will insert the timecode text in your form. This timecode will be turned into a link in your comment that will play the audio at that point.

Audio Feedback:

You can attach an audio file to a comment by using the advanced form. To do so, click the link above the comment form that says “audio comment”. This form will look similar to the text comment form, but will have a button to choose a file to attach.

When you save your comment, the audio file will be available to listen to beneath your comment.
