- 602-94 Mortgage Payment on Twin Sinks 4-13-91
A payment of \$5,000 will be made within one week toward repayment of the Mortgage on the "Twin Sinks" property in Alpena County, held by Harley J. and Barbara Ennest, the money to come from the following funds:
 Preserve Acquisition, \$576.00;
 Alpena, \$3,000;
 Preserve Acquisition and Management, \$1,424.
This payment will include the remainder of the gift of \$10,000 to Michigan Karst Conservancy from William C. Stevens and Archibald H. Stevens, accepted 17 November 1990.
- 602-96 Mortgage Payment on Twin Sinks 8-24-91
A payment of \$4,000 will be made within one week toward repayment of the Mortgage on the "Twin Sinks" property in Alpena County, held by Harley J. and Barbara Ennest, the money to come from the Preserve Acquisition and Management Fund.
- 602-99 Mortgage Interest Payment on Twin Sinks 11-16-91
The interest due on the Mortgage on the "Twin Sinks" property in Alpena County, held by Harley J. and Barbara Ennest, due on 15 December 1991, in the amount of \$636.98, will be paid with funds coming from the Preserve Acquisition and Management Fund.

- 602-106 Mortgage Payment on Twin Sinks 4-4-92
The remainder owed on the Mortgage on the "Twin Sinks" property in Alpena County, held by Harley J. and Barbara Ennest, plus interest owed, will be paid prior to 15 April, 1992. \$341.02 to come from the Preserve Acquisition and Management Fund, and the balance of \$628.71 from the General Fund, of which \$42.73 is interest.
- 602-111 Naming "The Stevens Twin Sinks" 8-22-92
The MKC property heretofore known as "Twin Sinks", Alpena County, is named "The Stevens Twin Sinks" unit of the Thunder Bay Karst Preserve, in recognition of the gift by Archibald H. Stevens and William C. Stevens, which made possible the acquisition of the property by MKC.

- 602-139 Parking Area Plan for Stevens Twin Sinks 4-27-96
Ty Black is allowed to develop and implement plans, with Executive Board approval prior to implementation, for the parking area of the Stevens Twin Sinks Preserve of the Thunder Bay Karst Preserve.
- 602-140 Authorization of Expenditures for Parking Area at Stevens Twin Sinks 8-24-96
An expenditure of \$1010 is approved for development of the parking area, access roads and culvert at Stevens Twin Sinks of the Thunder Bay Karst Preserve.
- 602-144 Authorization to Negotiate Deed for Bruski Property 11-16-96
Archie Stevens is authorized to negotiate the deed for the Bruski 2.5 acre property (approximately NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec 9, T32N R6E Long Rapids Twp, Alpena Co., MI) adjacent to the Stevens Twin Sink Preserve. The board also authorizes the President to execute the transfer of the deed to the MKC for the subject property. The board states its intention to name the karst feature on the subject property The Bruski Sink.
- 602-156 Authorization to Proceed with Cleanout and Fencing of Bruski Sink 3-20-99
The Thunder Bay Karst Preserve Committee is authorized to proceed with the cleanout and fencing of Bruski Sink as a 319 Project, subject to executive committee approval of MKC expenditures.
