Registration Information

Prerequisites: It is important that students come into the course with a sufficient mathematical background. This is why the course has enforced mathematics prerequisites. Acceptable mathematics courses are listed in the LSA course guide. An advisory prerequisite is Economics 101 and 102.

Registration: I do not give overrides to students who don't have the required mathematics prerequisites. My experience is that the course does not fill up, so that students who pass the required prerequisites late, during the summer, should still be able to register for the course. Please note that the number of students in the lecture or in any single section will not be increased, and that students cannot switch sections. Graduate students cannot enroll for this course before classes start. This is because the course is primarily for undergraduates.
