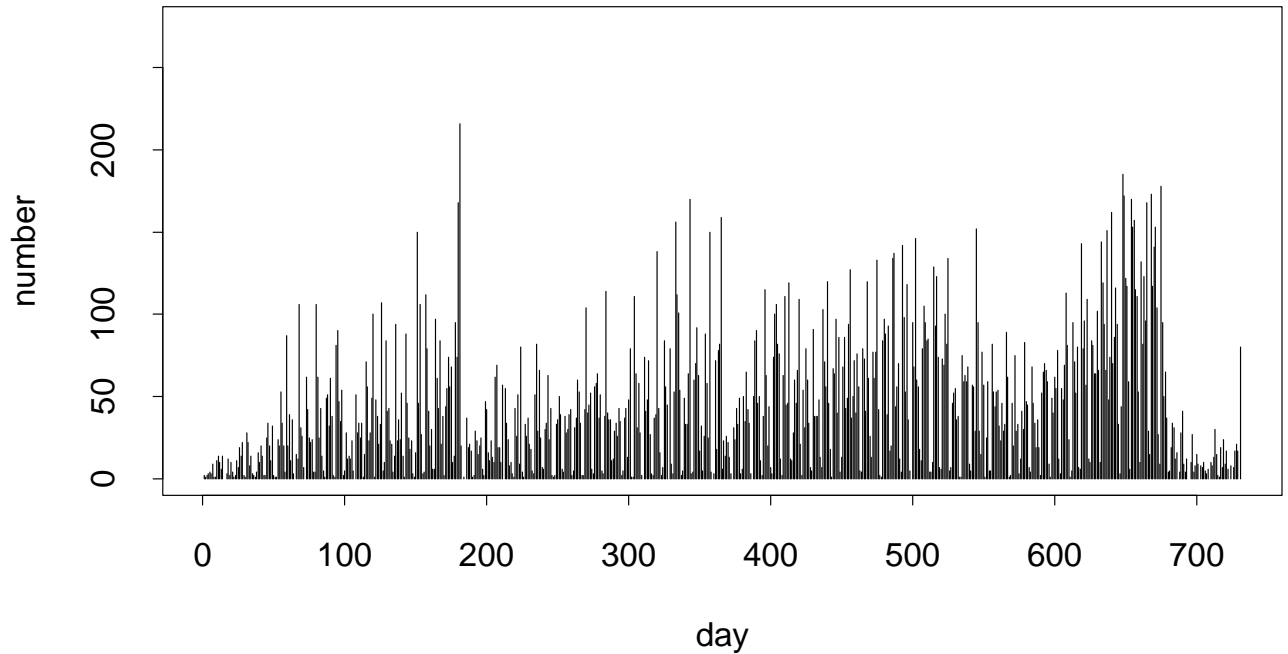


Figure 9i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1983–84, by Candidate's Party

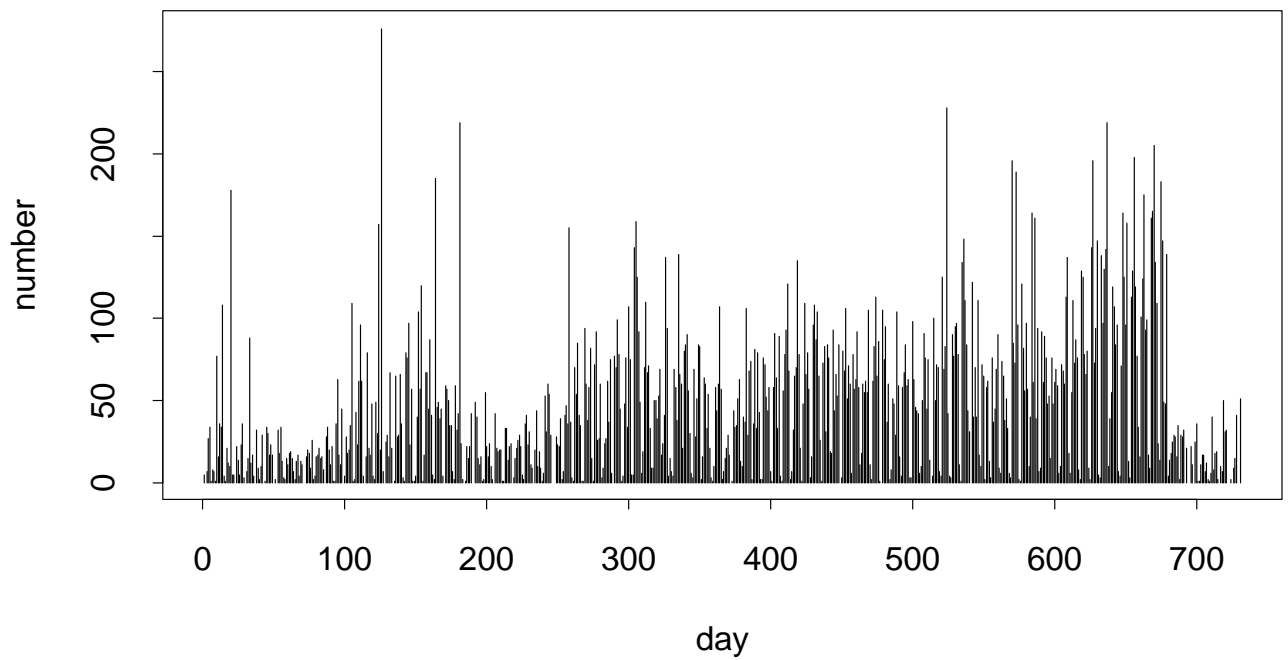


Figure 10i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1983–84, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

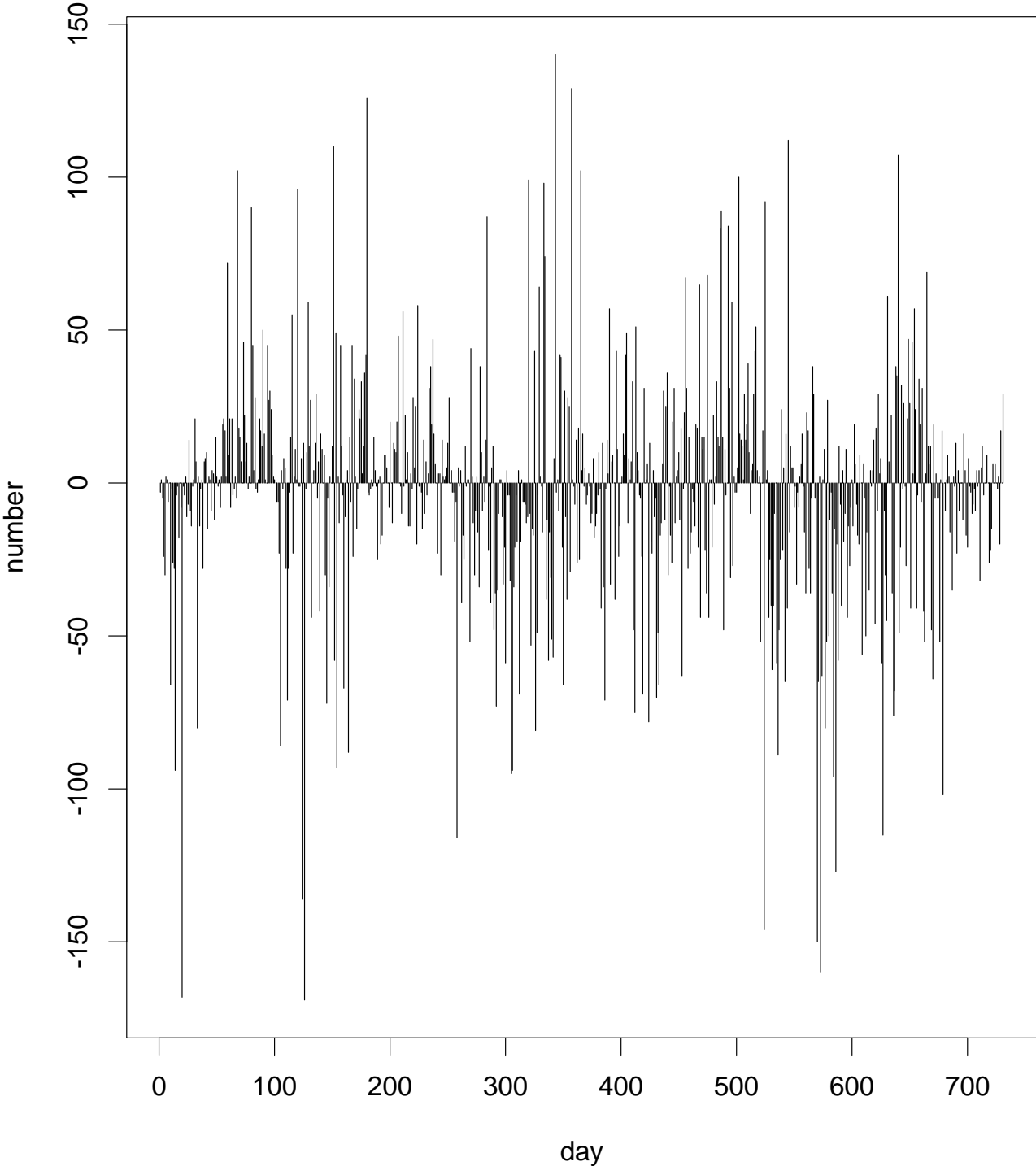


Figure 10c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1983–84, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

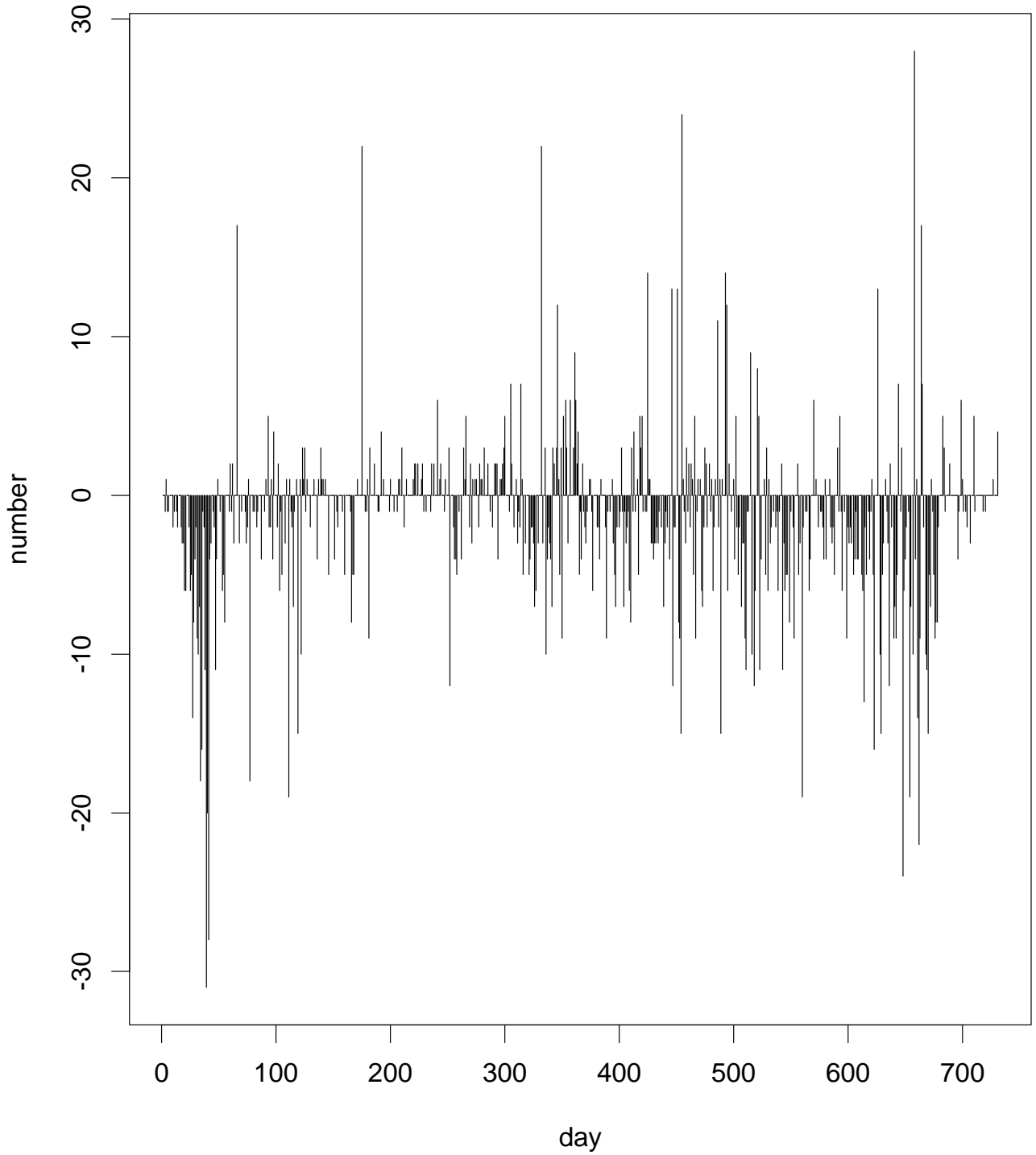


Figure 14i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1985–86, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

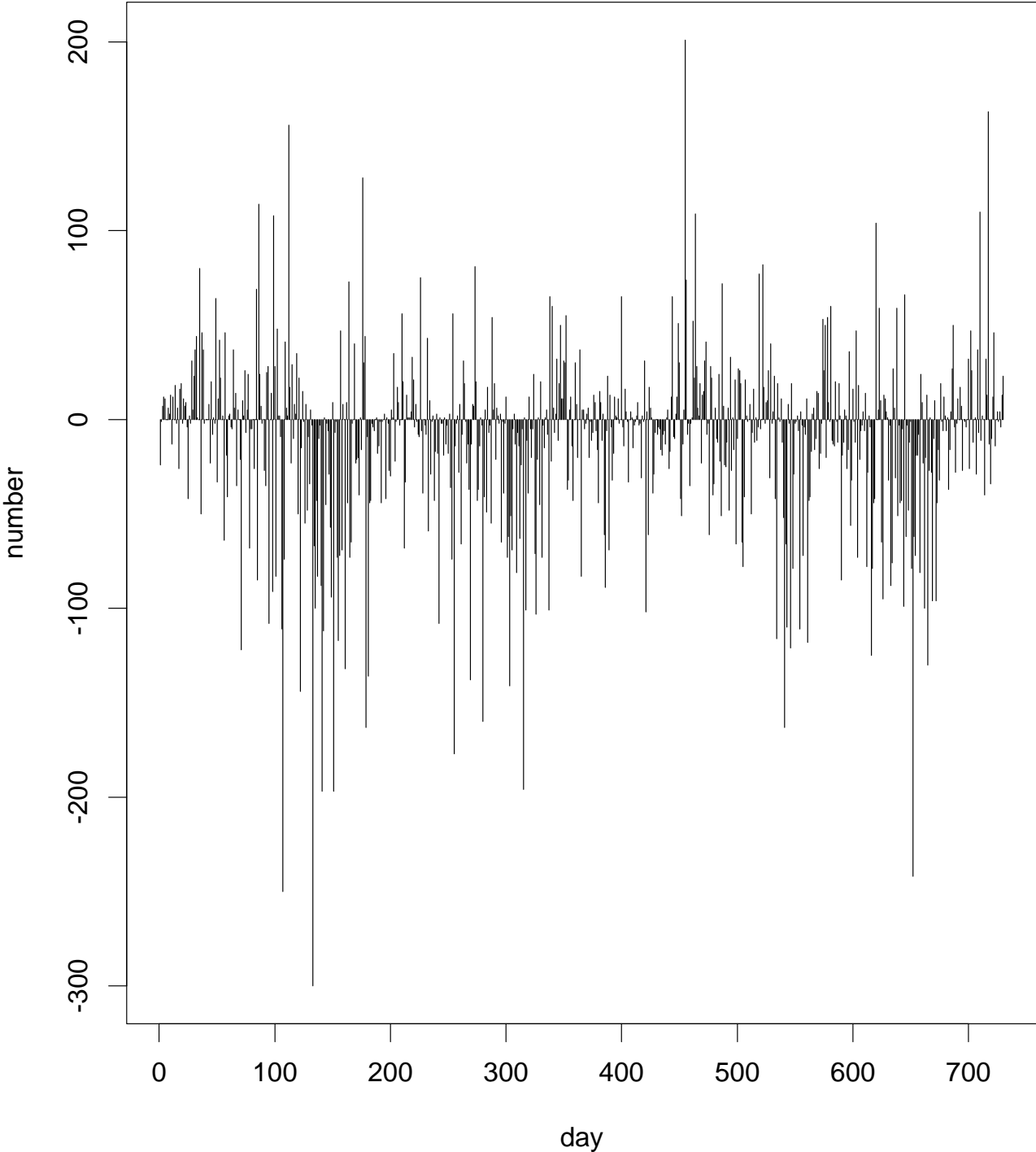


Figure 14c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1985–86, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

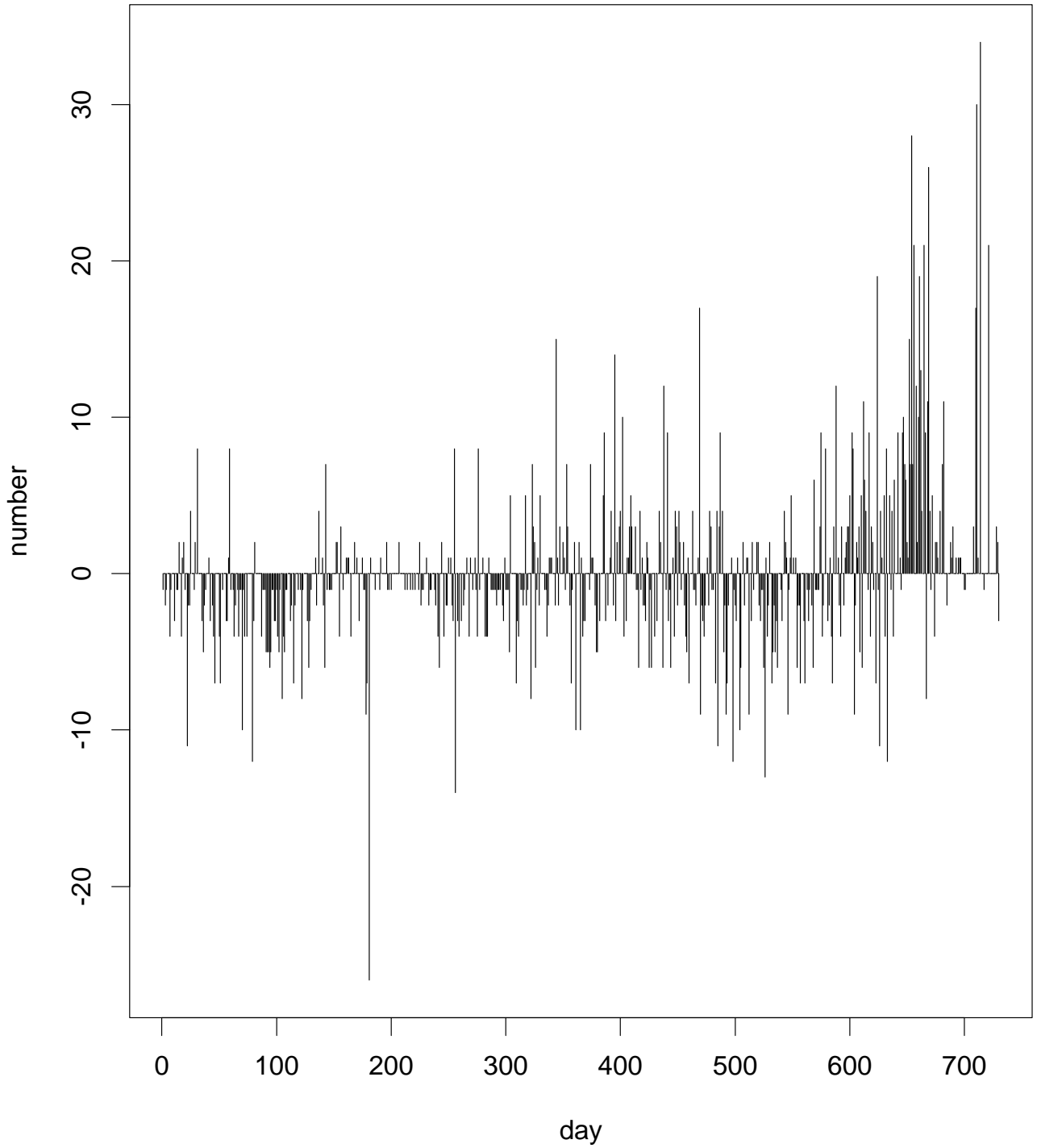


Figure 18i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1987–88, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

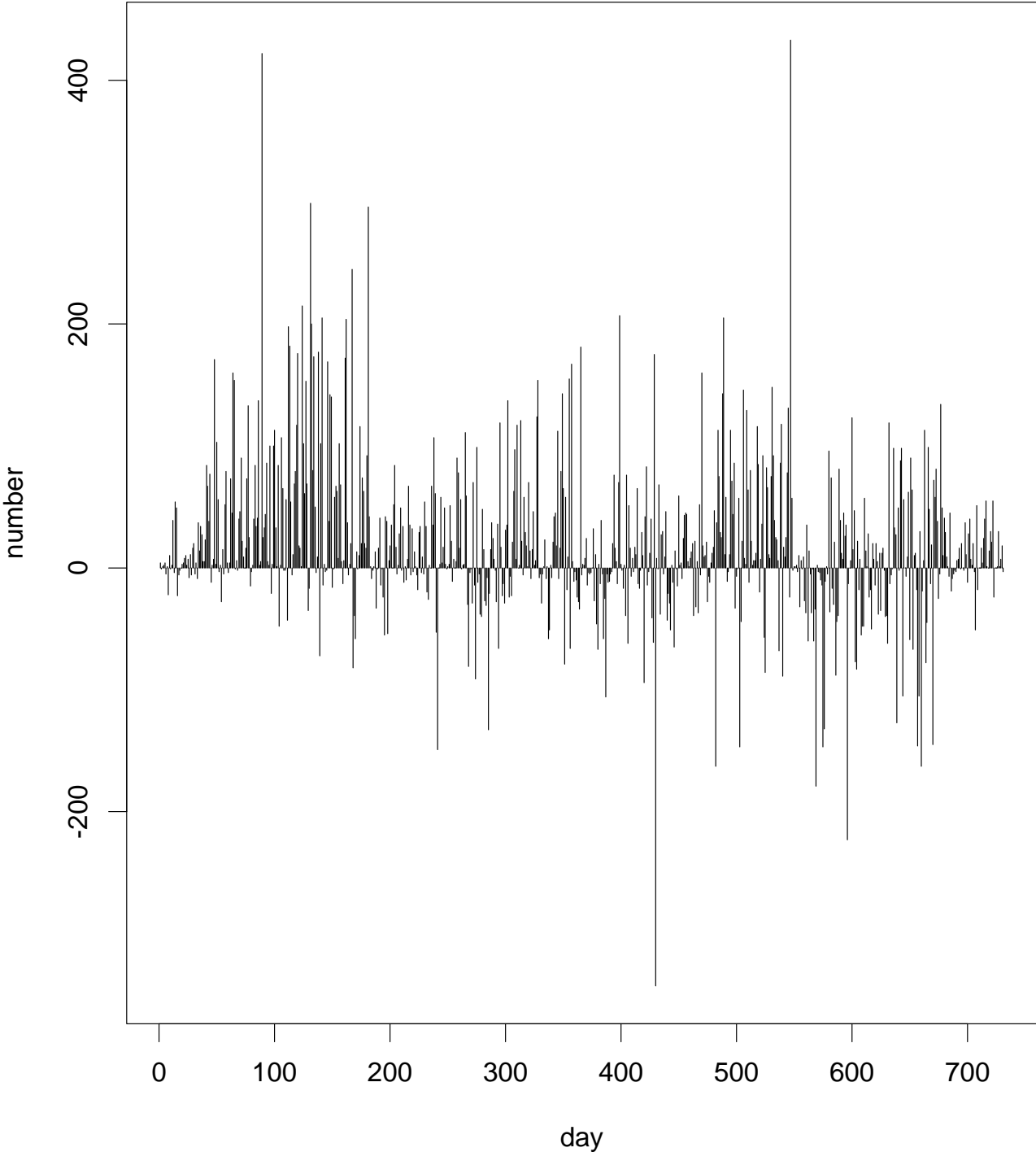


Figure 18c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1987–88, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

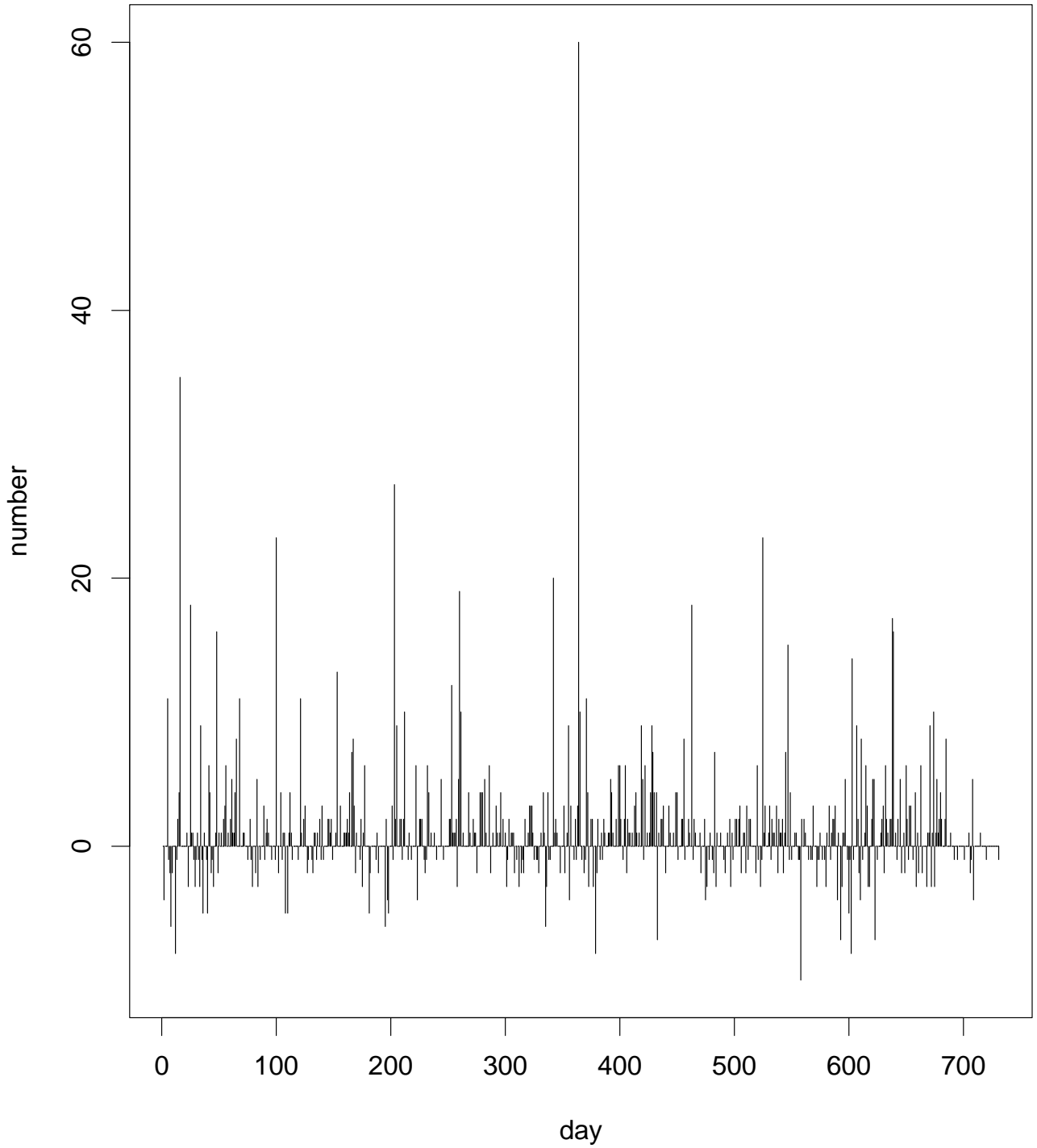


Figure 22i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1989–90, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

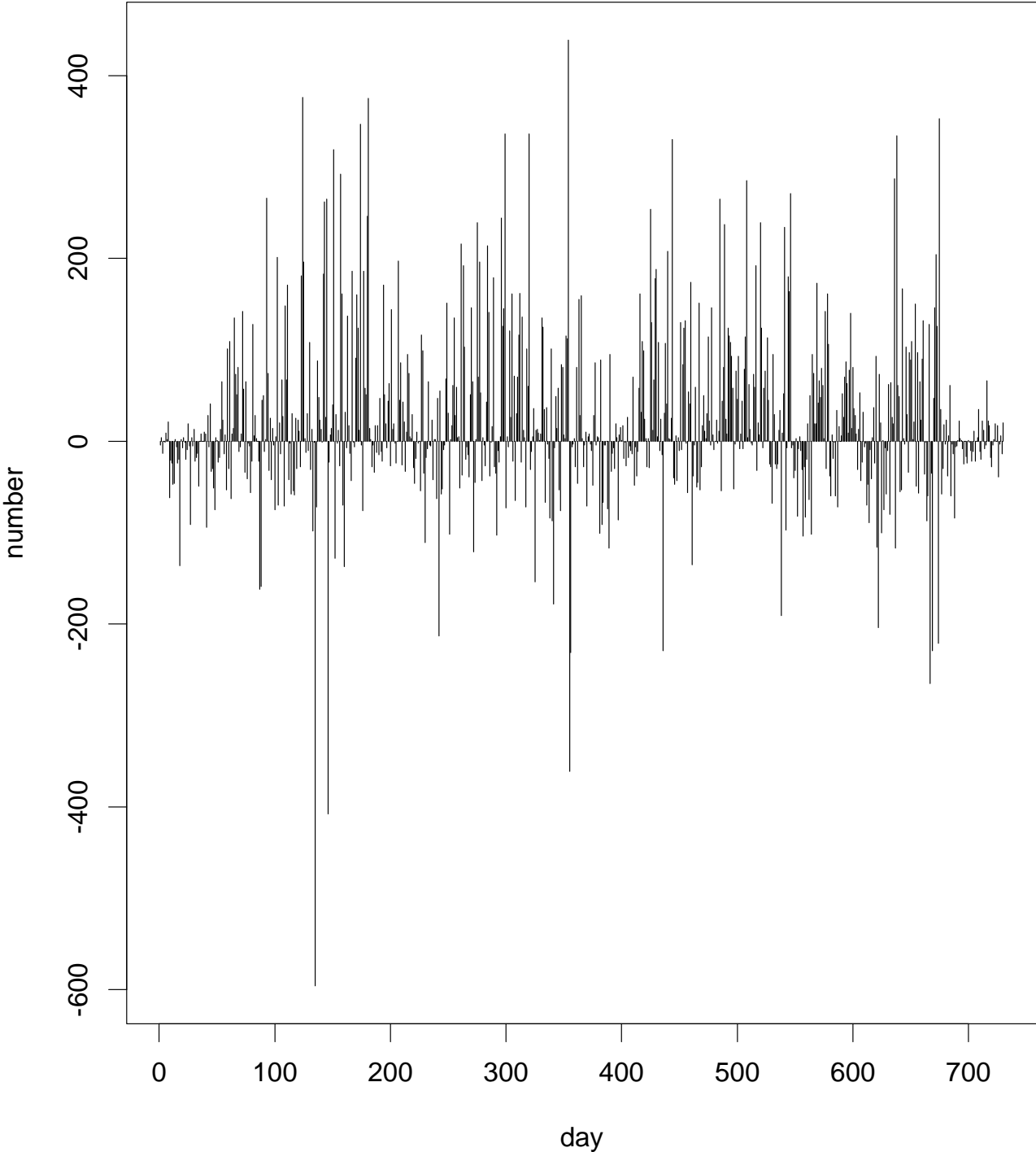


Figure 22c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1989–90, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

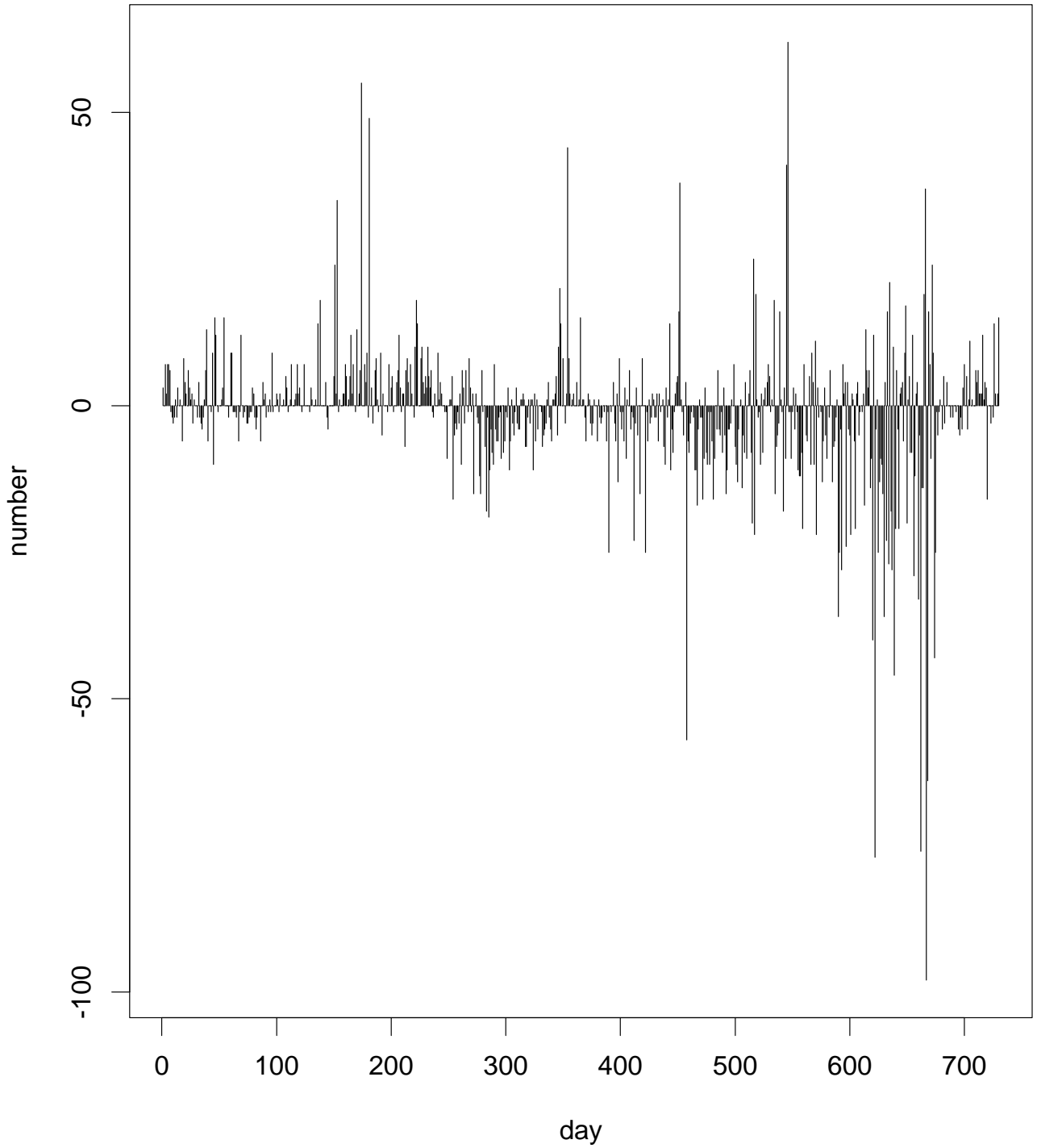


Figure 26i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1991–92, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

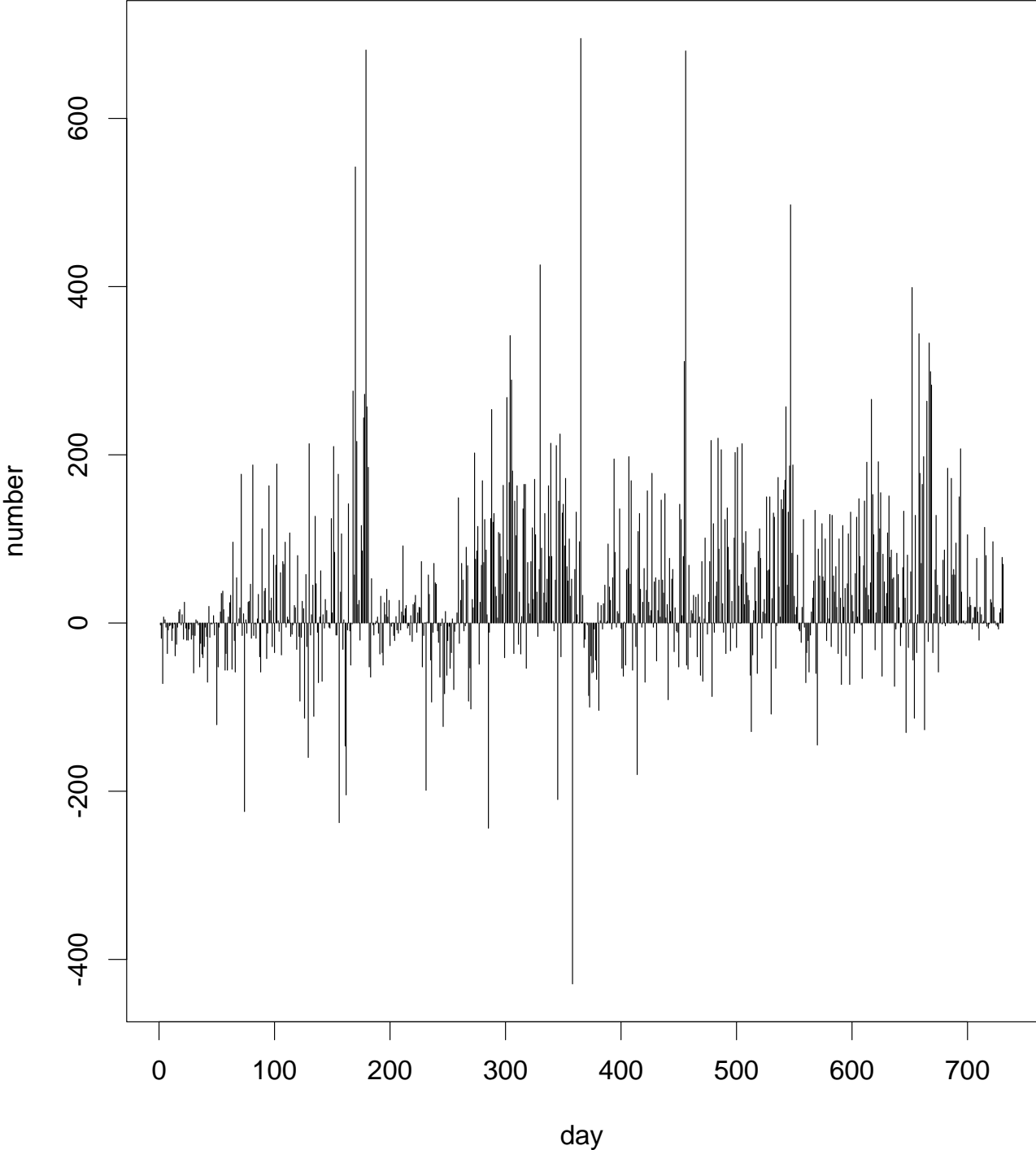


Figure 26c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1991–92, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

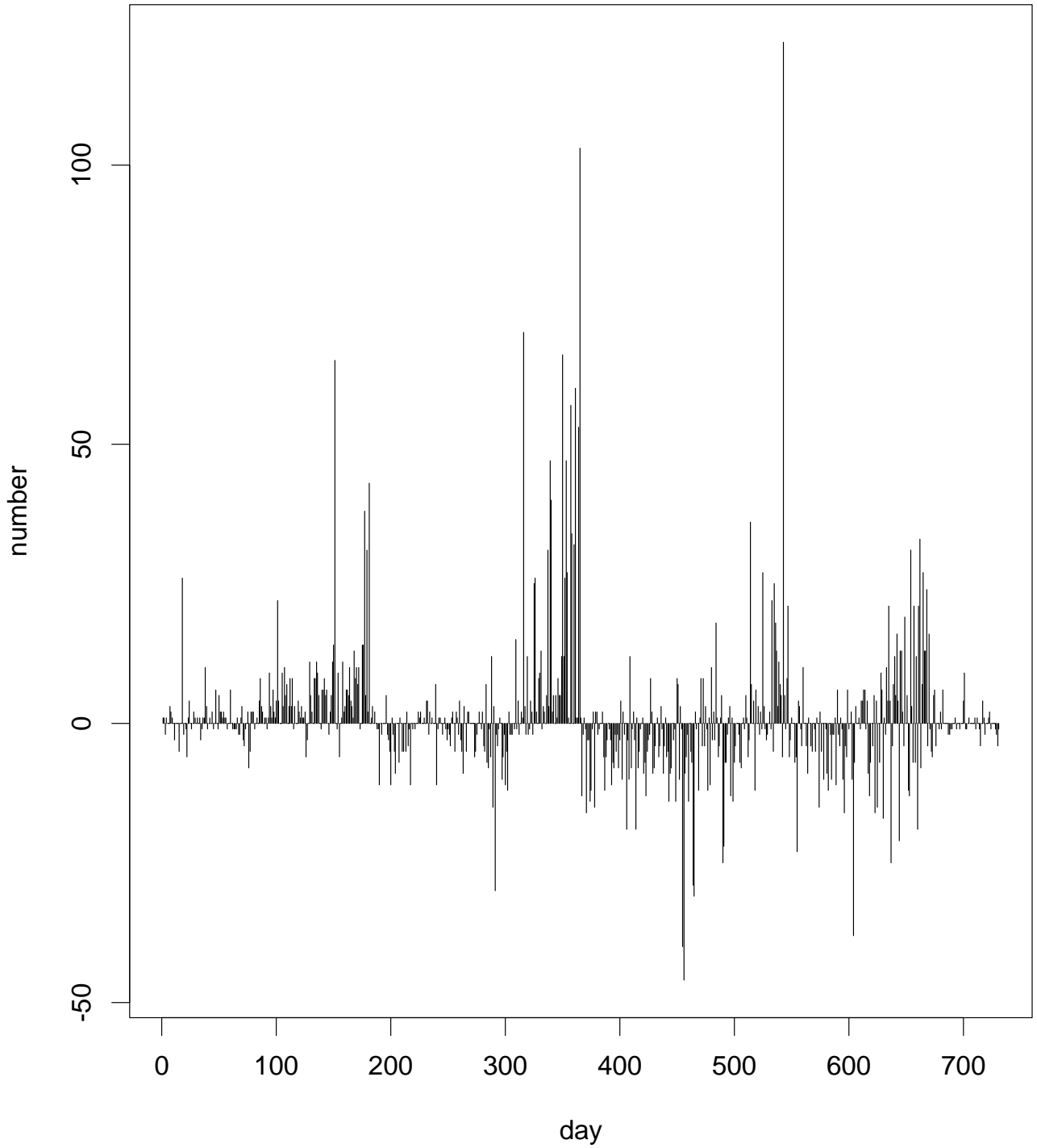


Figure 30i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1993–94, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

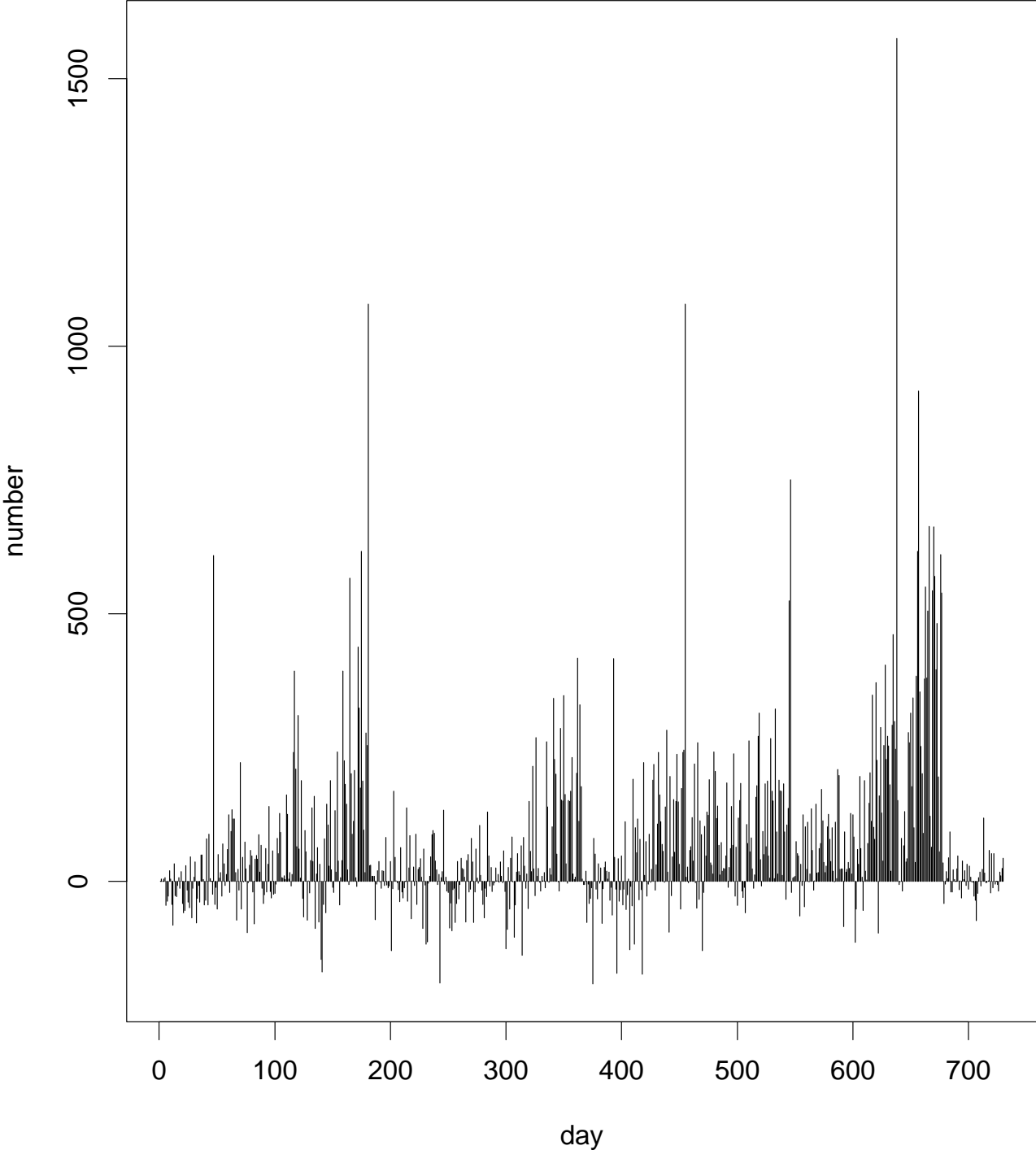


Figure 30c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1993–94, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

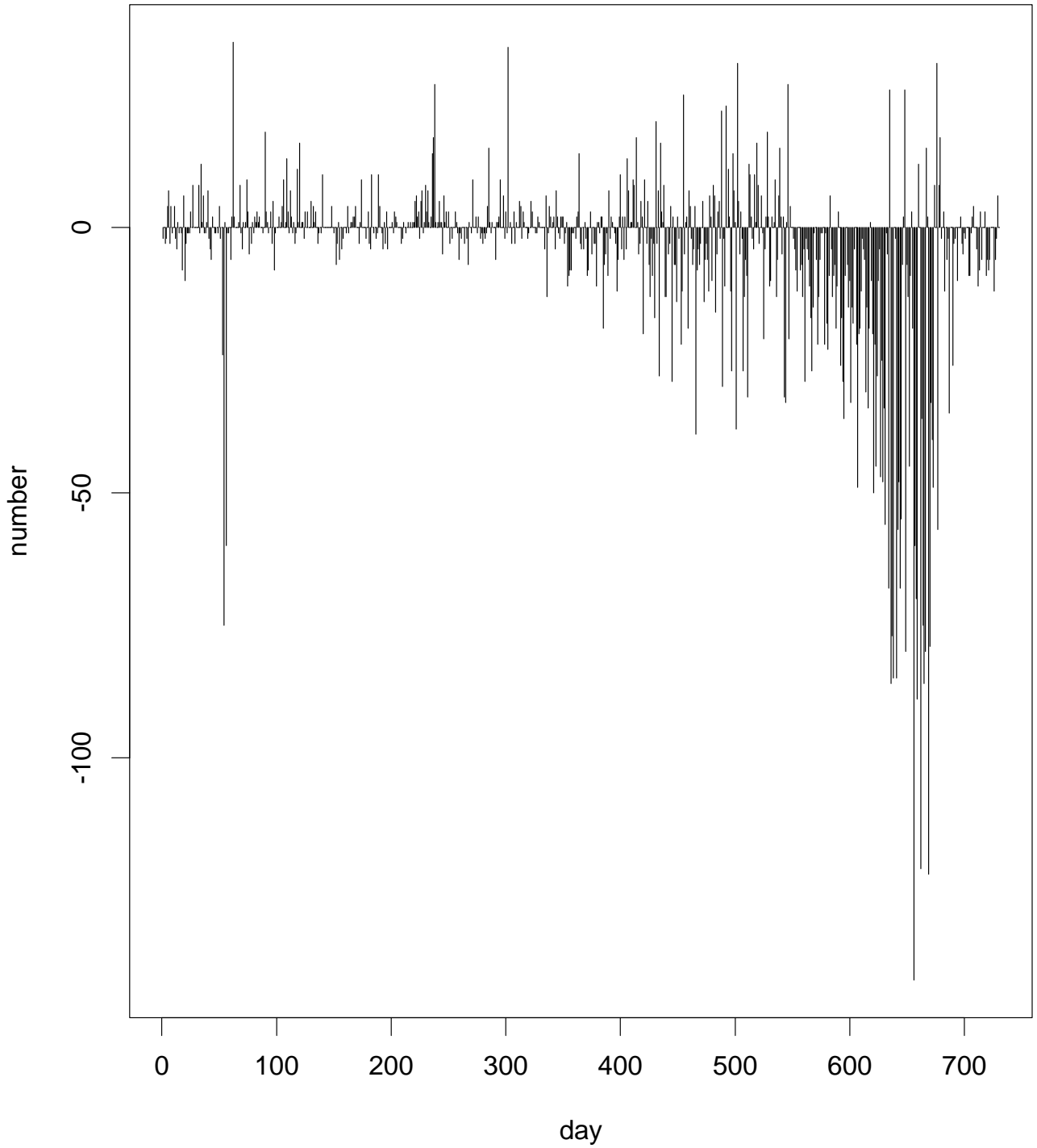


Figure 34i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1995–96, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

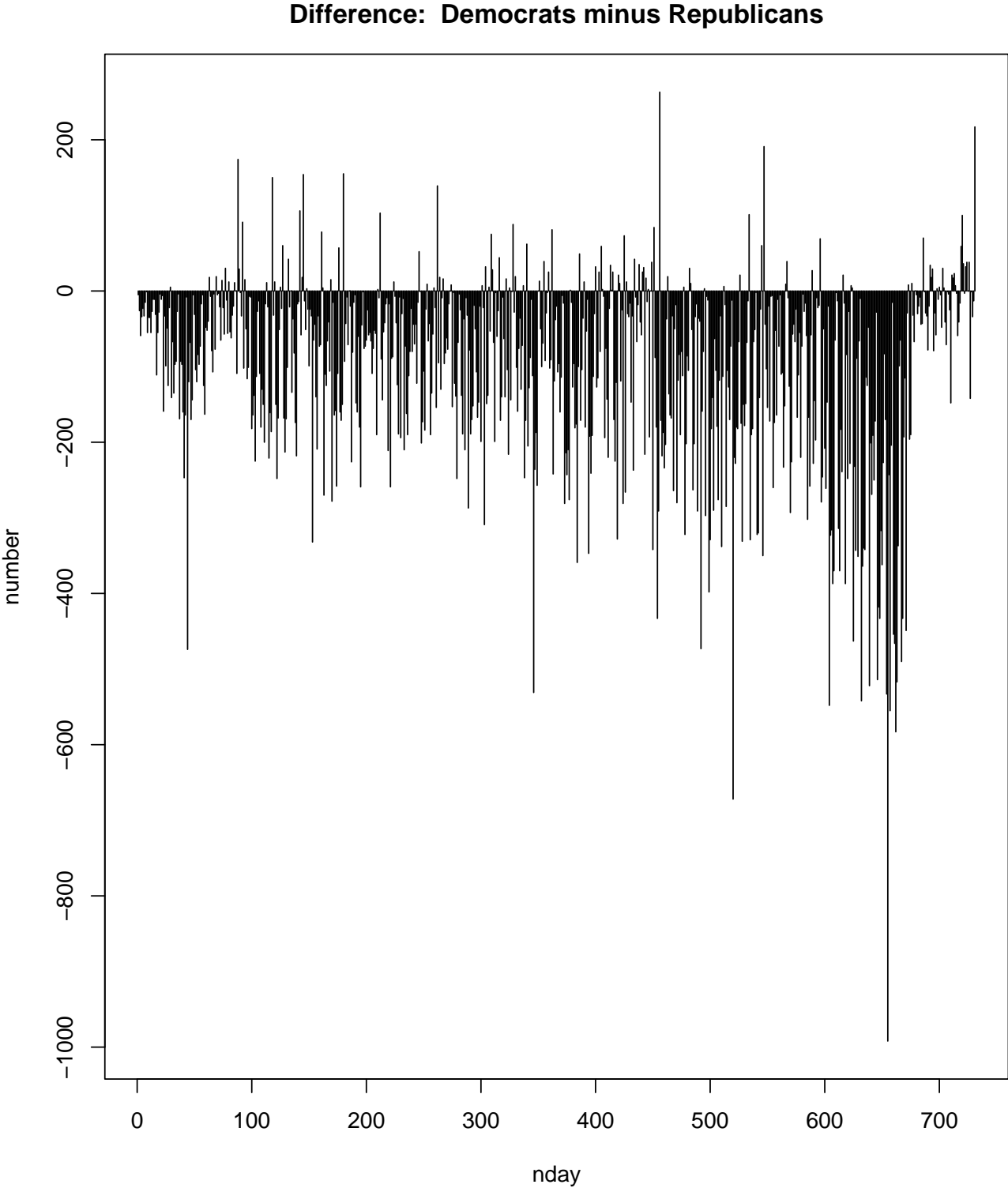


Figure 34c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1995–96, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

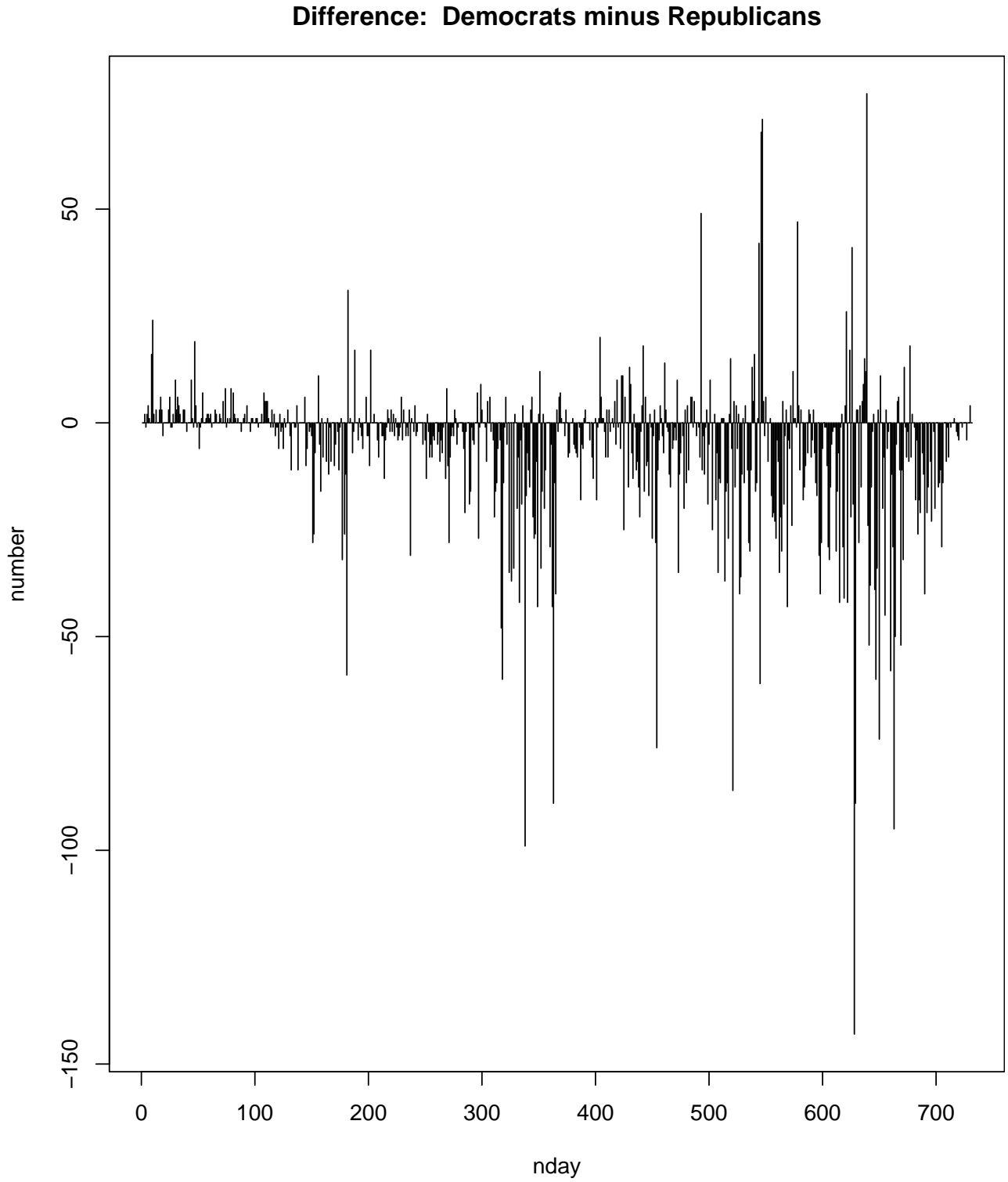


Figure 38i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1997–98, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

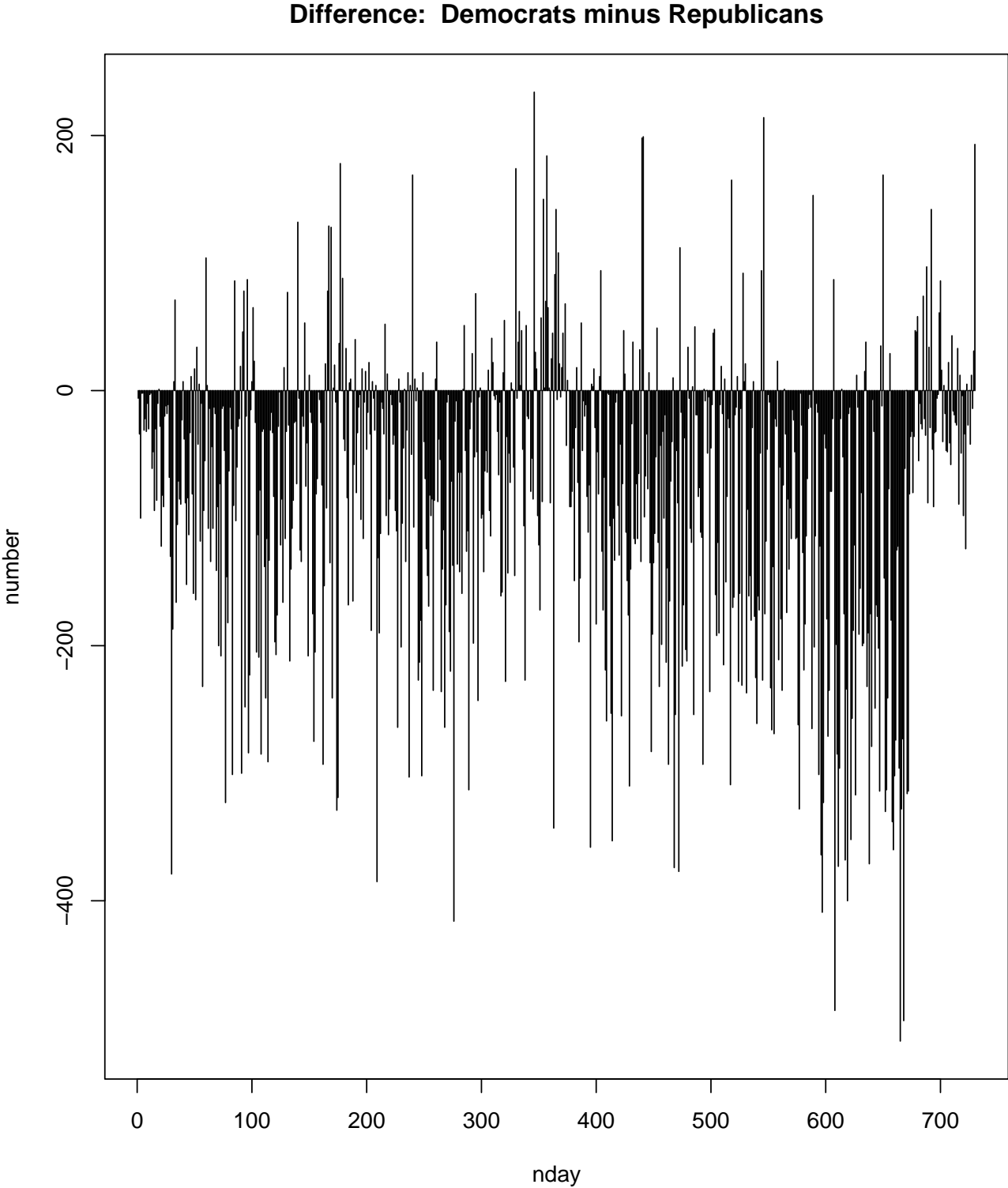


Figure 38c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1997–98, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

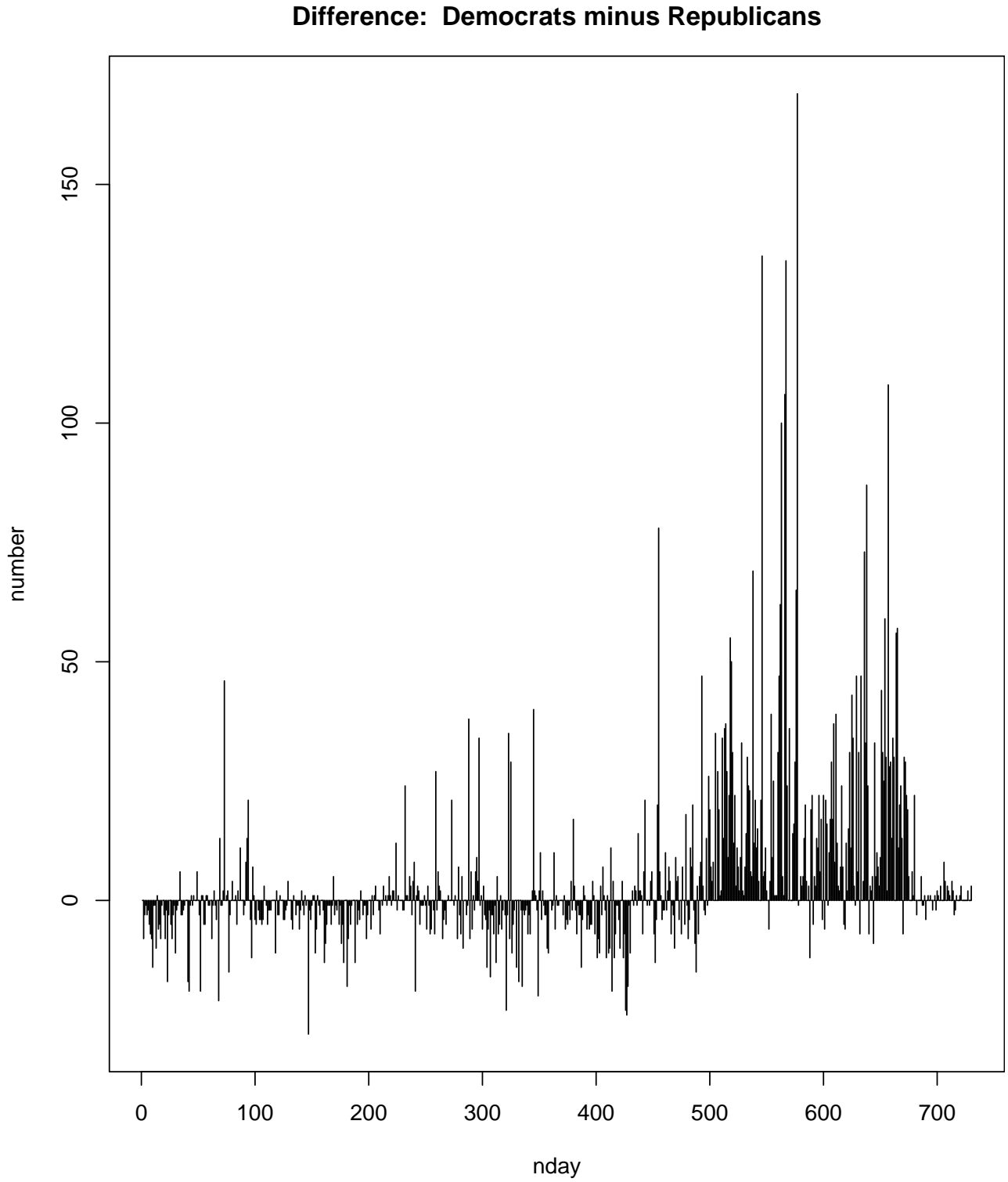


Figure 42i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1999–2000, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

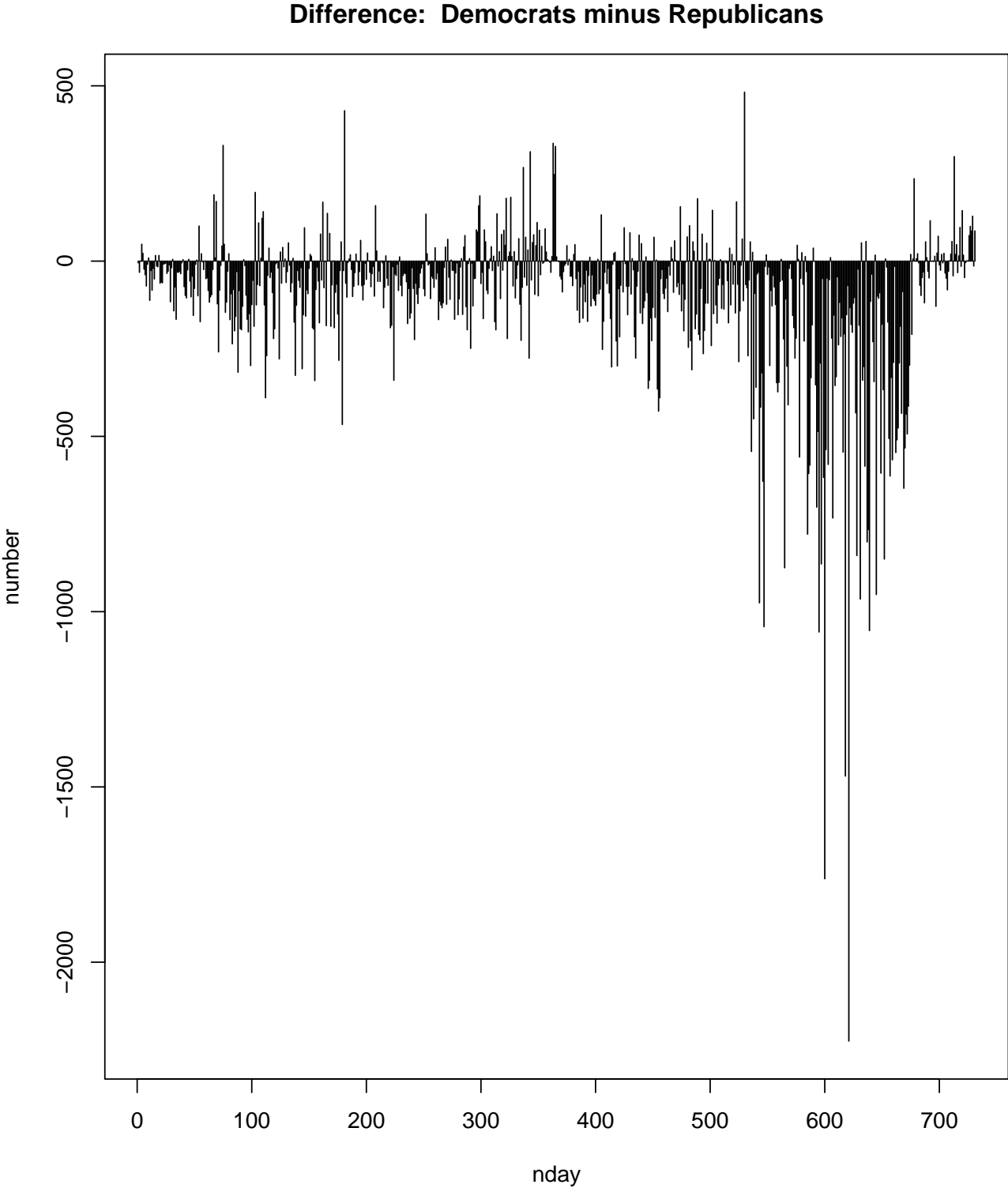


Figure 42c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1999–2000, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

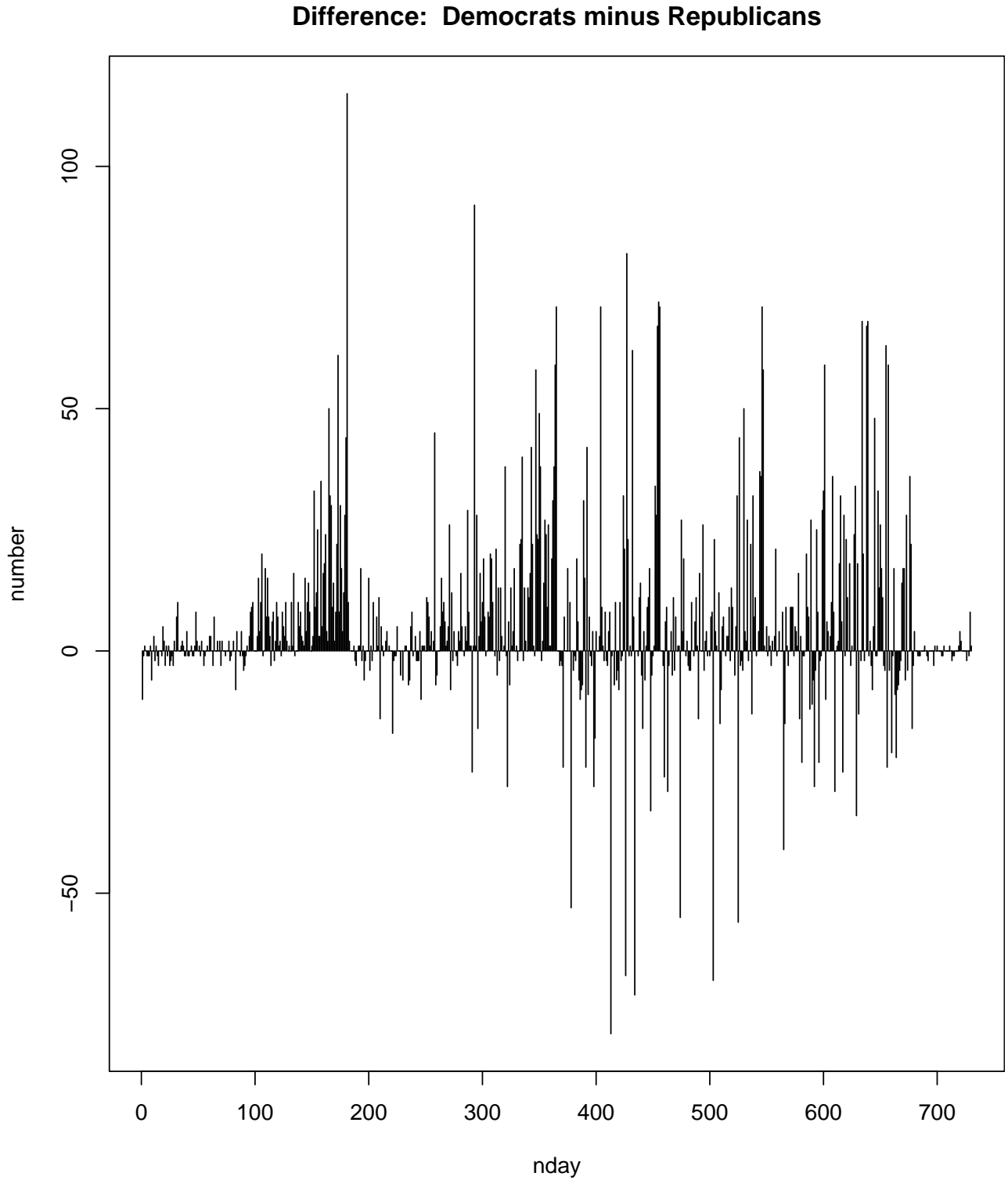


Figure 46i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 2001–02, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

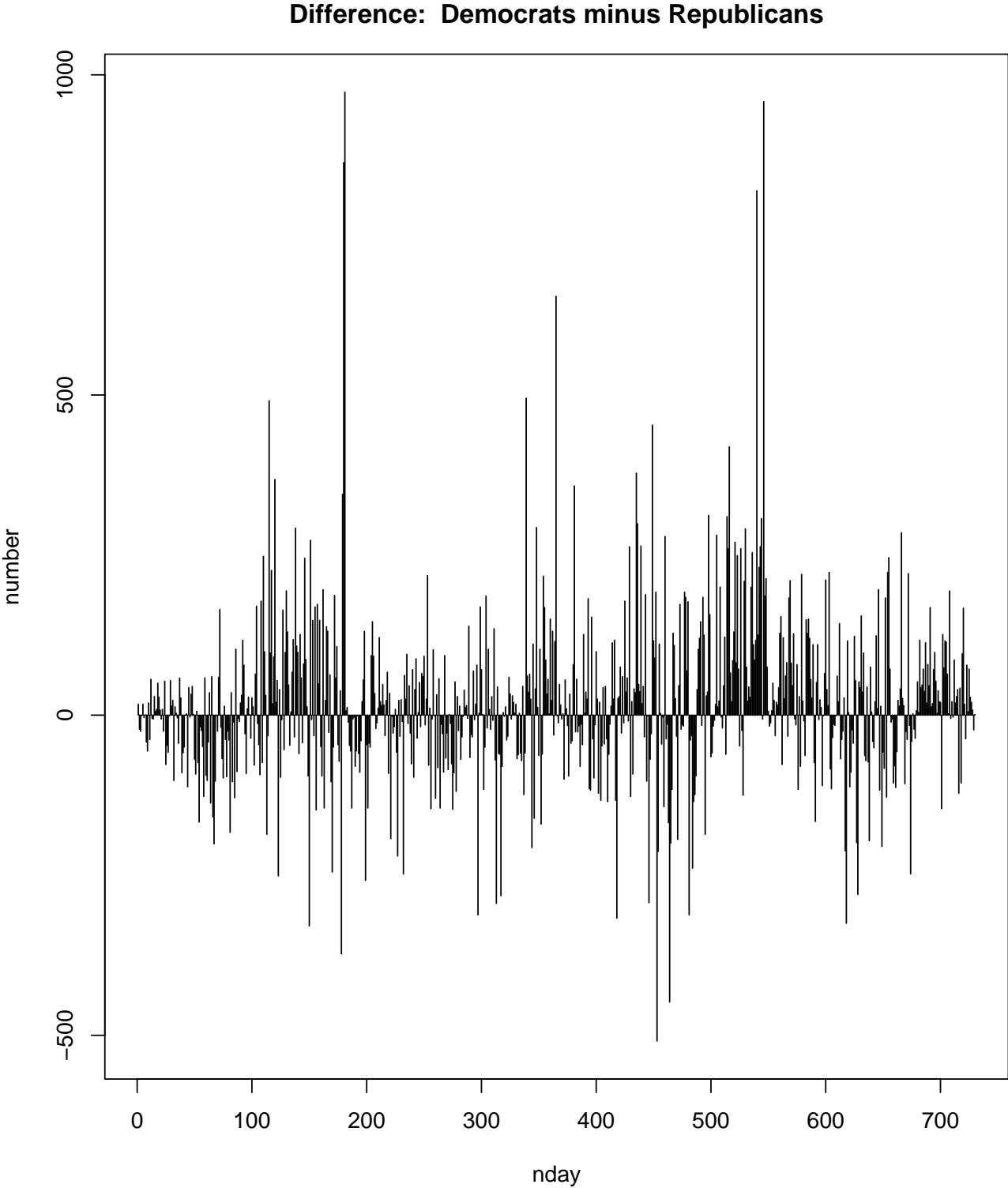


Figure 46c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 2001–02, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

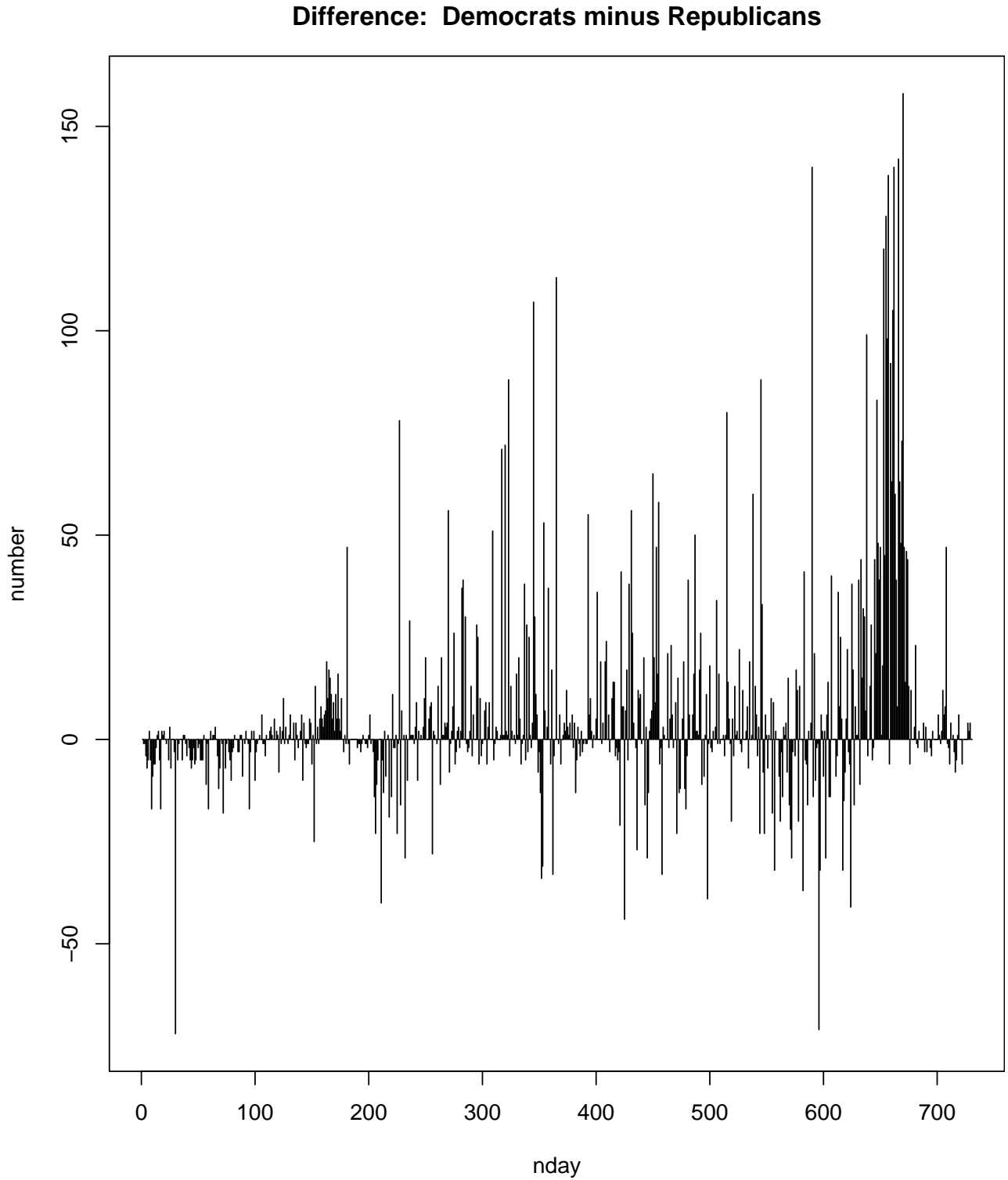


Figure 50i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 2003–04, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

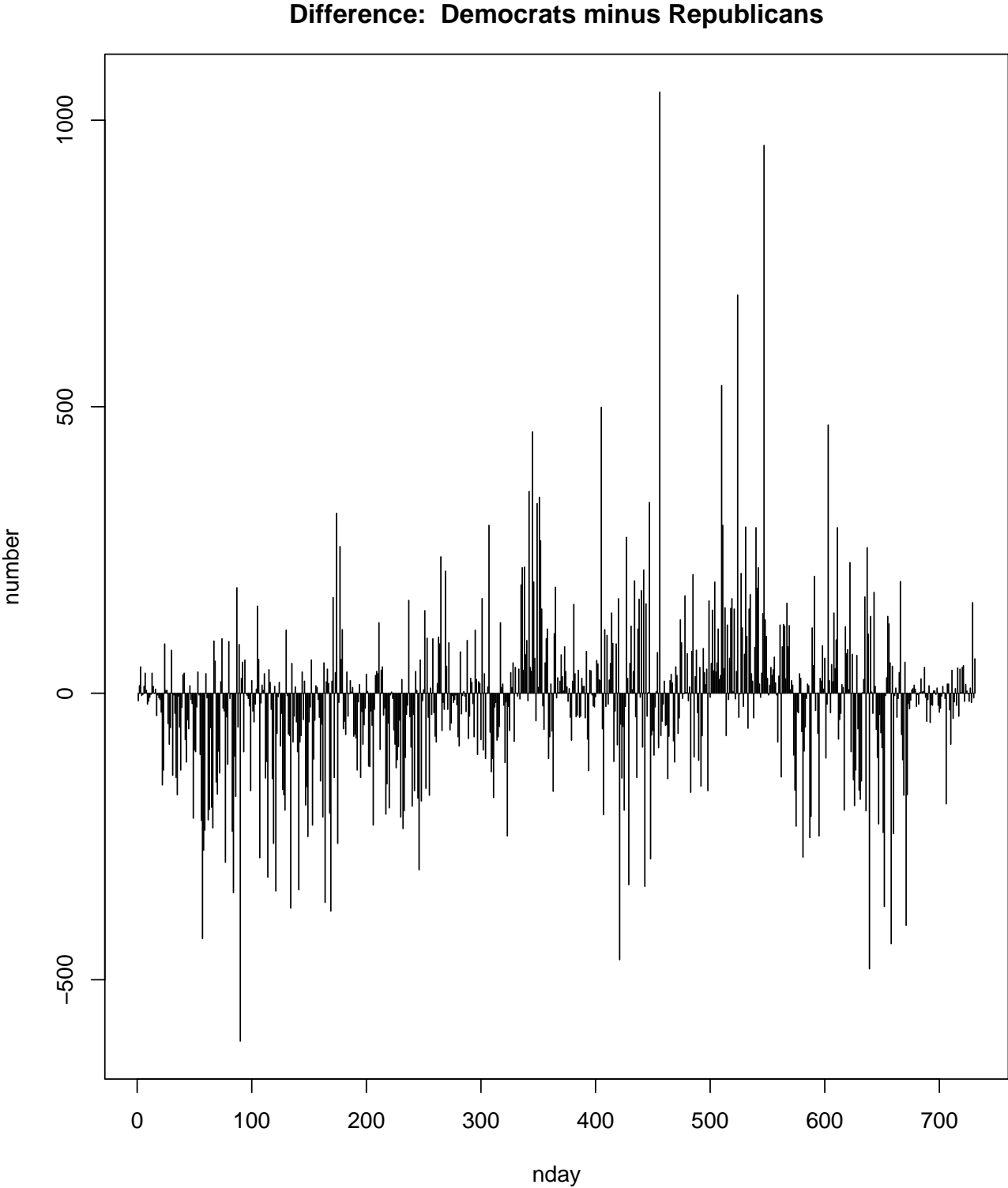


Figure 50c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 2003–04, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

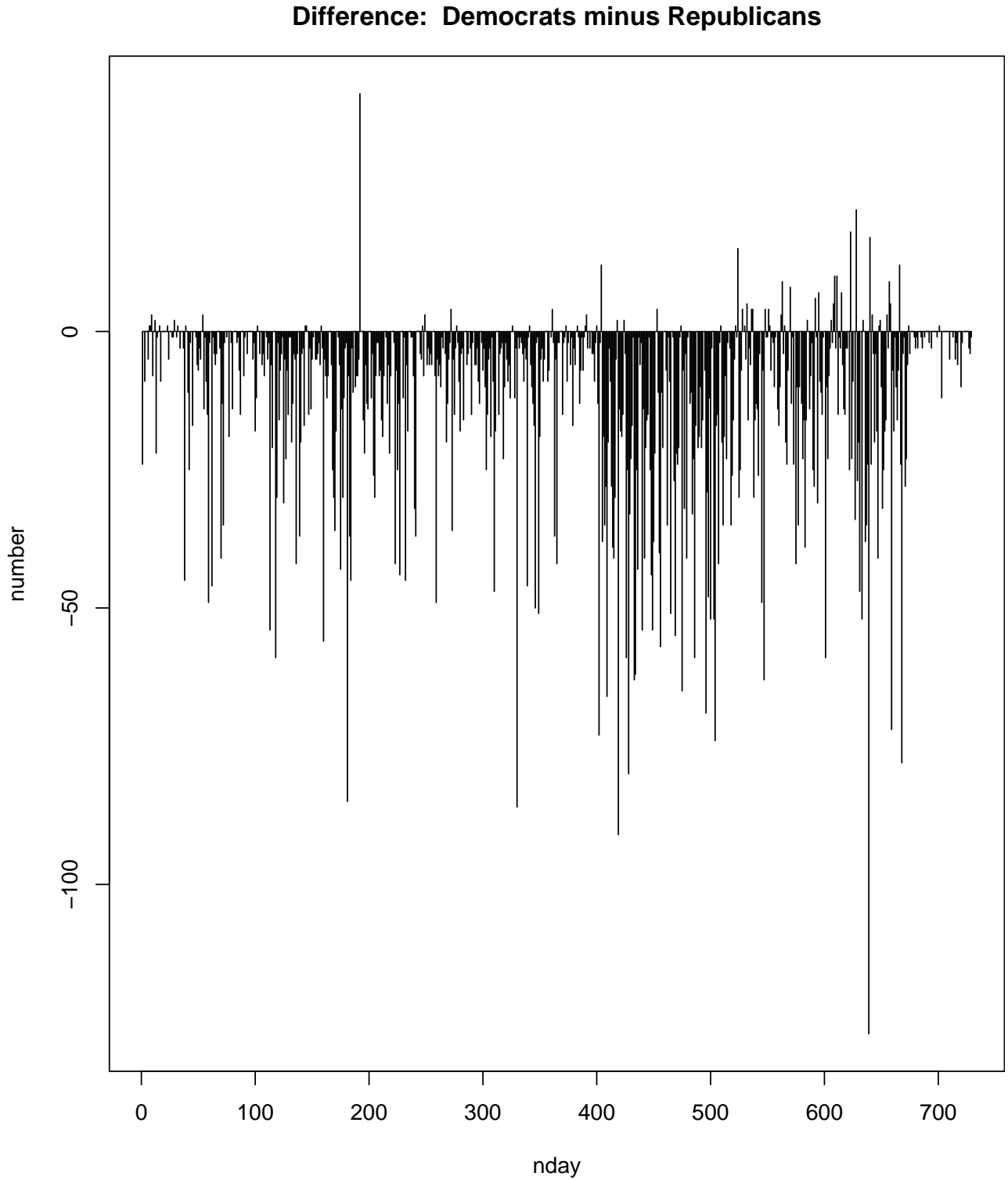


Figure 54i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 2005–06, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates

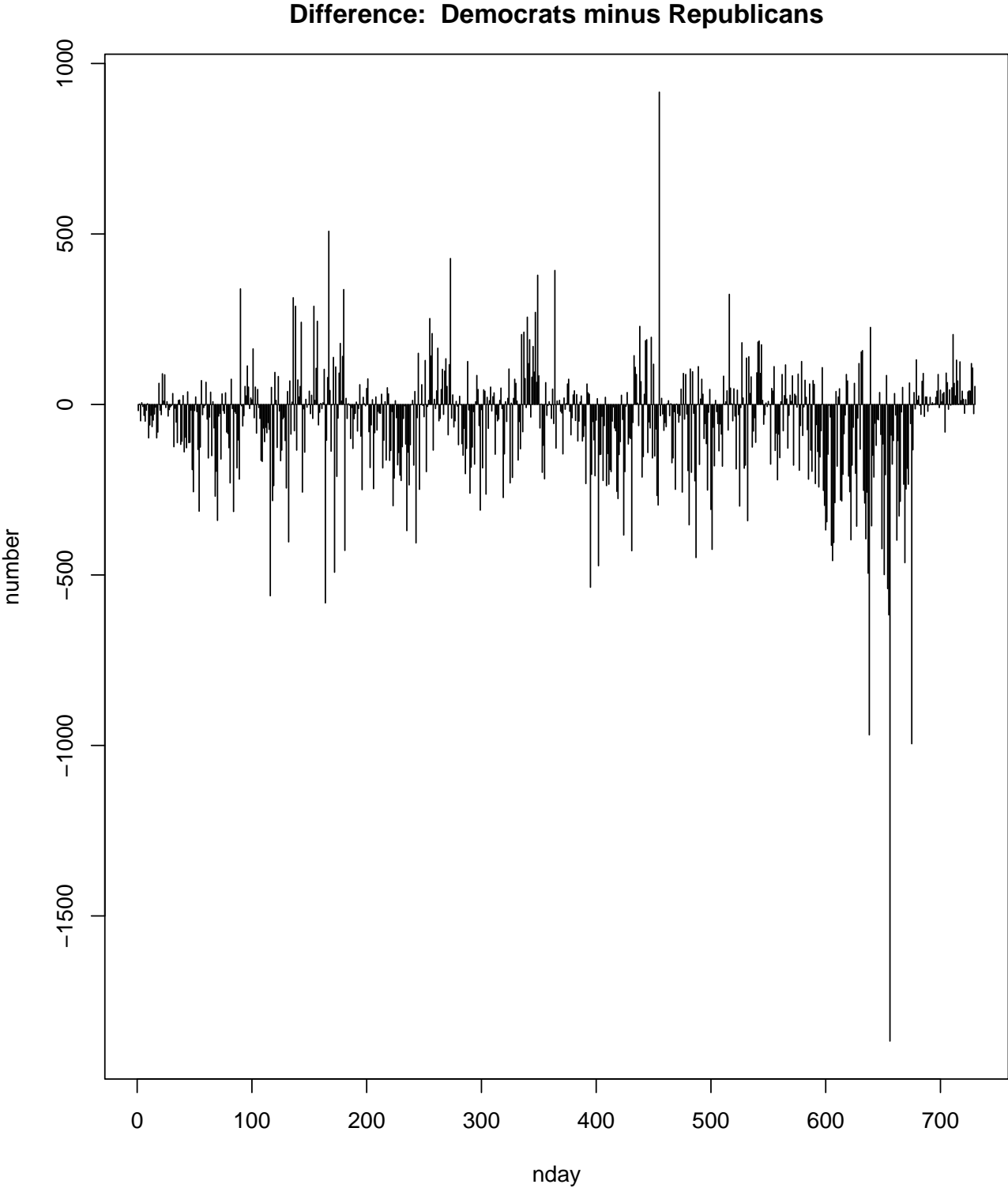


Figure 54c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 2005–06, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates
