Dear Mr. Yin,


Every year Automatica identifies around 20 individuals, from a pool of about 2000 reviewers, as *outstanding reviewers*. The selection is done following a nomination process that involves the Editors and Associate Editors of Automatica and is based on outstanding performance an individual has shown as a reviewer, consistently during the indicated period.

It gives me a great pleasure to inform you that you have been selected as an outstanding reviewer for Automatica for the year 2015, covering the review period July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015. You have been identified because of the thorough, competent and timely reviews you have prepared at the request of one or several Automatica Associate Editors. The editorial process depends heavily on the quality and timeliness of the reviews collected, and I am indeed grateful to you for contributing to this process in the most professional and responsible way.

In the period indicated above, 2235 individuals have prepared reviews for Automatica, whose names have been published in the December 2015 issue of the journal.
