Know ye, That *Henry Kinsey*, of *Virginia*

having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at *Cincinnati* -
whereby it appears that *He has made full payment for*
Lot or Section number One, of Township number
Three, in Range number Five. (East of a meri-
dian line drawn from the mouth of the Great
Miami River.)

_____ of the lands directed to be sold at *Cincinnati*,
by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States
in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and
of the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto the said
Henry Kinsey, the _____ lot or section _____
of land above described: To have and to hold the said _____ lot or
section _____ of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Henry*
Kinsey, his _____ heirs and assigns forever.
