Whereas John Rohrer of Montgomery County Ohio

subject to sale at Fort Wayne (Indiana) Containing Eighty acres.

**NOW KNOW YE,** That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said John Rohrer  
*and to his heirs* the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said John Rohrer  
*and to his* heirs and assigns forever.
