the North half of the North East quarter of Section two, in Township thirty six, North, of Range five, East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at La Porte, Indiana, containing sixty seven acres and seventy nine hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR**

GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *Daniel Hay.*

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *Daniel Hay,*

and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *Daniel Hay,*

and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
